Protocols for IConnect High School to address and prevent COVID-19

It is our number one priority to protect the health and safety of students and staff and to open the school and remain open. Please keep in mind as you review the information we are making the best decisions as we can based on guidelines from the Colorado Department of Education and the Colorado Department of Health and Environment. This plan is subject to change as circumstances are rapidly evolving.

Plan for safe return to in person instruction

- Teachers and Students will be highly encouraged wear a mask or face shield while on campus that covers mouth and nose. Masks are readily available for them to use.
- Students will be in person learning but if COVID-19 symptoms exist or students test positive, the district will have them remote in to Google classroom and participate in class via remote learning.
- Students and/or Staff that exhibit mental health concerns will be referred to mental health services in the community.

Daily routines to prevent and monitor the spread of COVID-19

- Students and Staff are encouraged to take their temperature at home before leaving for school.
- Students and Staff will have their temperature taken as they walk into the building using a non-contact infrared forehead thermometer. Temperatures WILL be recorded.
- Students and Staff will use hand sanitizer as they walk into the building which is located by the front door.
- Students will practice social distancing by reducing the number of students in class, limiting movement throughout the school, and using different routes for passing periods.
- Disinfecting methods using disinfectant spray and wipes will be done throughout the day every day.
- Rapid COVID tests will be available to take if students are experiencing any symptoms of COVID. The administration will administer the COVID test and record the results.
- If Students test positive for COVID they cannot return before the 5 days of quarantining AND they do not have a fever.

Review of COVID protocols

- Administration will stay up to date on the changes by the CDC on the COVID protocols.
- A review of the IConnect Protocols will be on a semester basis or as needed.
