Saxony Choir and Band Information!

- Chamber Choir Auditions: If you were planning on auditioning for Chamber Choir, it is not too late to audition. Just email Mrs. Rivers (mrivers@saxonylutheranhigh.org) to set up a time for Auditions. Auditions will include a vocal warm up to establish vocal range and then you will sing a song of your choice (only need to sing one verse and one chorus)
- Community Beginning Band: Mrs. Rivers is starting a community beginning band this fall. She will take as young as 5th grade and will go up through high school age. Saxony Small Group Leader Information



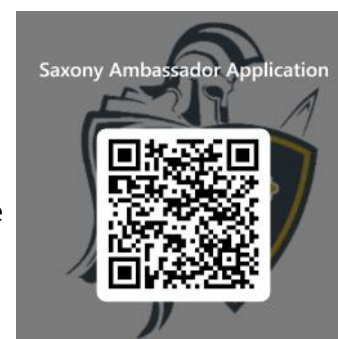
Attention Small Group Leaders!

Before the 2023-2024 school year begins, ensure that your child is currently in-line with the Missouri School Immunization Requirements. Please provide documentation when vaccinations are received, and **be aware the state re-quires two doses of the MCV (meningococcal conjugate) vaccine for our Senior students.** Updated immunization records may be emailed to kward@saxonylutheranhigh.org or they may be brought/mailed to the Saxony office.

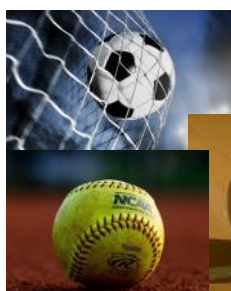

REGISTRATION DAY INFORMATION

Registration Day is Thursday, August 10, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

It is important that every student attend. If neither parent nor student can attend, please contact the school office. You will still need to come to school before your first day to take care of registration tasks.

Things to Do in the COMMONS...

Your first step is to stop by the ***Crusader Check-In Table*** to pick up your schedule, your temporary lunch card, and check-out sheet. Then visit these stations in any order, as you may need to.

Saxony Boosters: Please visit the Booster Club table to find out how you can be part of this group that supports Saxony activities and to purchase some great Saxony spirit items.

Service Hours: If you have any service hours to turn in, please be sure to bring them to the Registration Day. Mr. Simpson and Mr. ZumHofe will be on hand to collect these forms and field any questions from new and returning students. Forms are available in the School Resources section on PlusPortals or at Registration Day. The service hour record will be available if a student has questions as to how many hours that they have turned in. If you have any questions, please feel free to email Mr. Simpson at msimpson@saxonylutheranhigh.org.

Lockers: Do you want a locker this year? Stop by the table to request a locker.

Submit Paperwork: You can turn in physicals, parking permits, and immunizations records. All student drivers are required to register their vehicle and obtain a parking permit to utilize the Saxony parking lot.

Development: Stop by the development table and register to win a \$500 scholarship for the 2023-2024 school year.

Things to do in the GYM...

School Pictures: All students, including seniors, need to have a school picture taken. Students are not required to be in uniform when taking their photo. These photos are used in the yearbook and for the student id's. Seniors are also required to have a formal portrait taken. All clothing will be provided for the senior photos.

NEW CRUSADER DAY FOR ALL NEW STUDENTS

Attendance Policy

If you are aware of a future absence, please inform the school ahead of time rather than waiting until the day of the absence. Also, if a student is visiting a doctor, college, or anywhere a note can be obtained, please have the student turn the note into the office the next time they sign in to school. **Please be sure to include a cell phone number that can receive text messages on the registration form, if possible.** This is very helpful if we need to get in touch with you quickly for attendance reasons. Lunch Accounts

Lunch account can be accessed and managed online through EZSchoolApps beginning Monday, August 14, 2023. The website offers parents a safe and secure way to pay for student meals online from any browser using EZ Parent Center. To sign up, create an account at **www.ezparentcenter.com**.

After signing up you will have the opportunity to:

1. Use your credit card to deposit money into your student(s) account anytime from anywhere using any browser. You can still add money to the account via cash, check, or debit/credit card in the school office to avoid a service fee.
2. View your student's account balances 24/7.
3. Track your student's payments and purchases.
4. Receive notifications when your student's account balance is low.

From the desk of Mrs. Kiehne:

Hello Crusaders!

Saxony is once again offering testing services on Saxony's campus during the 2023 - 2024 school year. You will have the option to select additional testing options for your student(s). Below is a listing of all required and optional testing provided on Saxony's campus.

Standardized Testing at Saxony 2023-24

Saxony students are offered several opportunities throughout the year to take standardized tests, such as the ACT, at school rather than off-campus at a college, university, or another high school. Some tests are required for some students, others are optional. Fees for mandatory tests will be included in your Registration Day total, but optional test fees may be paid for at that time as well, or prior to a deadline. Mrs. Kiehne will include reminders about these fees and deadlines in her weekly updates.

Here is a summary of each test:

Pre-ACT – ALL freshmen and sophomores will take this test on September 9th during the school day. The \$14 fee will be included in your Registration Day fees. The results from these tests will be reviewed with parents at Student-Led Conferences in October.

ACT – ALL juniors will take the ACT on March 12, 2024. The fee for juniors is \$25 and is included on Registration Day. We also offer the ACT in October for any junior or senior who wishes to test. Sophomores and seniors may also sign up for the ACT in March. The fee for each of these is \$60. (Note that juniors receive a fee discount for the March exam, since it is required.)

PSAT – This is optional for all sophomores and juniors on October 11, 2023. This test might lead to scholarship opportunities, including the National Merit Scholarship. The PSAT fee is \$35.

ASVAB – The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery is offered to juniors and seniors during the second semester. This test is free.

Saturday ACT & SAT testing – Students may also take the ACT and SAT on national (Saturday) test dates. Registration for these tests is done online by the student. Saxony receives a record of student scores, but we do not hold Saturday testing at Saxony. Test dates, deadlines, and registration for the ACT and SAT can be found online at act.org (ACT) and <https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/registration> (SAT).

Fee Waivers – Fee waivers are available to cover partial or total costs. If your family qualifies for free or reduced-price lunch (or some other criteria), please ask me about this before you register for the exams. These might apply to either in-school or Saturday testing.

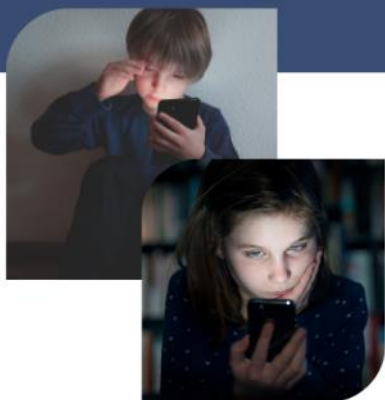
Special Needs – Some students have learning or medical concerns that warrant special testing circumstances. These can include ADHD, learning disabilities, or diabetes, for example. If you believe you might qualify for these please contact me early, as it can take several weeks to receive approval and make arrangements. We cannot support special testing for the in-school October ACT or for non-juniors on the March ACT, but accommodations are possible for Saturday testing or the PSAT.

SLHS Parent Electronic Resources

Whether you and your student are new to Saxony or returning, you may find the information below helpful in navigating different topics and task during high school with us.

Lunch Accounts: SLHS uses EZSchoolApps as our cafeteria point-of-sale system. This site offers parent accounts to view daily and past charges, current student bank balance, and a safe and secure way to add funds to student balances via online payments. There is a convenience fee associated with this online payment, so you may alternatively send cash/check to school or call school and the office can take credit card payments over the phone, all without additional fees. ***NEW** for the 23-24 school year, all primary contact parent/guardian email addresses of our SLHS students will be entered into the system. This allows for email notifications to be sent to the email inbox of a student's primary contact. We send 'student lunch balance under \$10' and 'lunch account negative balance' notifications. Once parents are uploaded into the system, welcome emails will be sent to the email address where account setup can be completed to login and access the above-mentioned options.

Sport Physicals: ***NEW** for the 23-24 school year, Privit! SLHS is excited to introduce a new and easier process for completing health history forms required before MSHSAA sport participation. Privit replaces the paper-based forms with an electronic solution for submitting and managing health information between parent, school office, and team coach. Parents will need to register (create) an account unless the parent has an existing account with Privit. As setup is finishing, parents will be notified via email from SLHS when all is ready for parents to register.

Communication: (PlusPortals, AdminPlus text for attendance & email of attendance) SLHS school information system suite (provided by Rediker, Inc.) allows integration of various services that allow school personnel to share communication with parents and students. Below is a summary of current communication methods through our SIS suite.

- Emails and text messages can be sent to parents and students, ie: regarding daily attendance
- Notifications via the SLHS app
- PlusPortals (ParentPlus and StudentPlus) allow students and parents to access information such as:
 - ◊ Attendance records
 - ◊ Student demographic information (including fields date of last physical exam on file at school and
 - ◊ Grades: current average per class and per assignment in each class
 - ◊ Semester grade reports
 - ◊ Discipline records
 - ◊ School notifications and email messages (note: email messages do show in your regular email inbox, but the portal does have an inbox that will show all messages sent from within the PlusPortals system. Email messages sent from PlusPortals show a generic email address (messenger@plusportals.com) as the sender, but a reply message can be made to the initial sender.
 - ◊ School Directory information
 - ◊ School Resources and School Announcements (links and files that school shares for your access)
 - ◊ E-Locker: (digital documents that school saves in E-Portfolio)
 - ◊ Forms: online forms such as re-enrollment, tuition assistance application
 - ◊ For Tutorials on using PlusPortals, <https://docs.rediker.com/plusportals/manager/parentplus-portal-327922.html> will take you to Rediker's interactive tutorials on a few ParentPlus features.

PlusPortals, by Rediker, offers StudentPlus and ParentPlus apps for iPhone and Android mobile devices, providing access to grades, attendance, class schedules, discipline, announcements, and alerts. Visit your mobile device app store for download.
