THIS WEEK'S SKILLS

We will study Unit 5, Lesson 3 this week:

Phonics- Sounds of long e spelled with e, e_e, ea, and ee

Comprehension Strategies- predicting, visualizing, plot, setting, asking and answering questions, clarifying, point of view, main idea and details

High-Frequency Word- be, green, or, take, two

Vocabulary Words- check, enjoyed, equipment, fight, local, spread, station, worry

Writing- Writing a persuasive poster

Grammar- Capitalization and use of commas with days of the week and month

Dictation- On Friday there will be a dictation test. The teacher will call out some of the sounds listed above and the students will write the corresponding letters to spell the words and sentence. *Students will also write two red words: here and be*
