#### **a. Amira Data and Progress**

#### **b. IXL Usage and Purpose**

The school recently purchased IXL to help address academic gaps and provide students with additional practice in key standards. The program is being used to personalize learning and support preparation for the Georgia Milestones Assessment System (GMAS).

#### **c. One Book, One School – *Magnolia Wu Unfolds It All***

Students and staff participated in the One Book, One School initiative featuring *Magnolia Wu Unfolds It All*. The school community enjoyed reading the same book together and participating in related activities, challenges, and discussions that promoted literacy and schoolwide engagement.
