Reminders

- Safety Drop off and pick up lanes are single lanes intended to keep cars from pulling around other cars and causing dangerous situations for children. Drivers are asked to not move or drive over cones. All children should exit car doors on side nearest the curb.
- Support Your Child's Learning: Drop Off by 7:50 and Pick Up at 2:55 Early pick up for any reason other than a doctor's appointment requires meeting with the principal at the time of pick up.
- Meetings with School Personnel by advance appointment only
- **Doctor's Appointments:** Call school in advance to tell us about early pickups for doctor's appointments. Provide the school office with a doctor's note validating the appointment.
- Monthly Payments Due the 20th of Each Month for tuition, books, extended day. We count on parents' timely payments to meet our expenses.
