How can I qualify?

- 18 to 24 Years old (Verified with State ID or Birth Certificate
- At Risk and/or Justice Involved
- Resident of Leon or Gadsden county
- Eligible to work in the U.S. (SSN or application req.)

What if I do not qualify for the program?

In addition to the re-entry program, Goodwill Mission Services has many other programs, partnerships, and resources to assist everyone in the community. We will work to help transition our referrals not eligible to enroll to other programs at Goodwill.

What can the Reentry **Program Help with?**

- Transitional Work Experience
- Transportation (bus passes, gas cards)
- Mental Health resources and Health Insurance
- Violence Intervention and **Prevention Courses**
