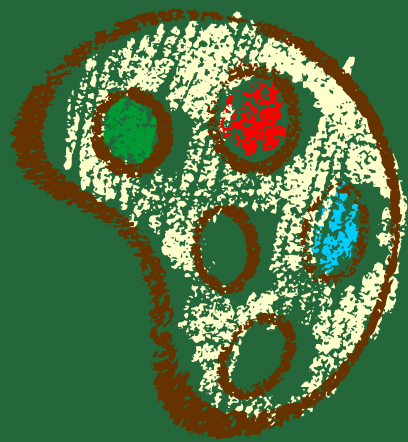


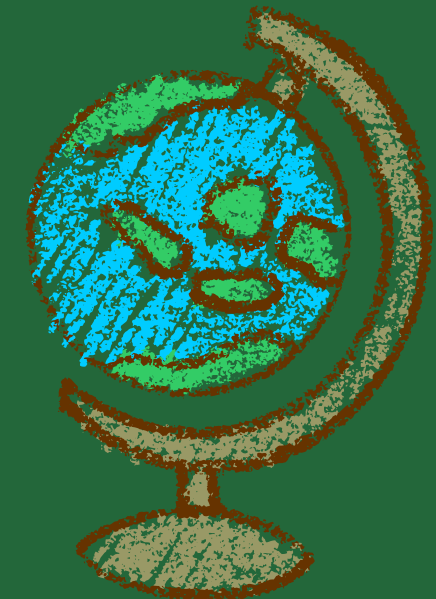

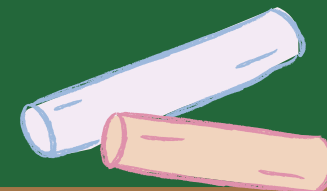

Water Bottles

What happens if the rules are broken?

Whether it is a school rule or a classroom rule, the following consequences may be issued. This plan is similar to the plan in Ms. Thornburg's room. The behavior plan coincides with the DPES

Behavior Management Plan.

Some steps may be skipped, depending on the severity or frequency of the offense

The fouls represent warnings. For example, after 2 warnings the student will have a conference with the teacher. After 3 warnings, the student will serve silent snack or lunch.

Fouls	Consequence
2 fouls	Student/Teacher Conference (Warning)
3 fouls	Student will serve silent snack/lunch.
4 fouls	Parents will be notified by phone call of student behavior.
5 fouls	Parent/Teacher/Administrator Conference
6 fouls	Referral to Administration for Habitual Class A Behavior.

In Ms. Thornburg's class, we will use Class Dojo Points. Points will be deducted from their Class Dojo. For every Dojo point earned for positive behavior, the student will earn a ticket. Prizes will be won weekly by a random draw. More tickets=more chances to win!



Grading Policy

All subjects will be 60/40.

60%--Major Grades (tests, projects, writing projects, presentations, etc.)

40%--Minor Grades (skills practice, fluency assessments, quizzes, DMR, homework, etc.)

Other Information

Students cannot bring fidgets, poppers, spinners, etc to school. They will be taken up until dismissal if students bring them to school.

Make sure you are at school everyday! You don't want to miss out on all the fun we have in class!

Parents are not allowed to eat in the lunchroom everyday. We will host Family Lunch Days once each semester.

Parents will enter through the front doors of the purple hall.

Lockers

Carpool drop off and pick up is in the front of the school.

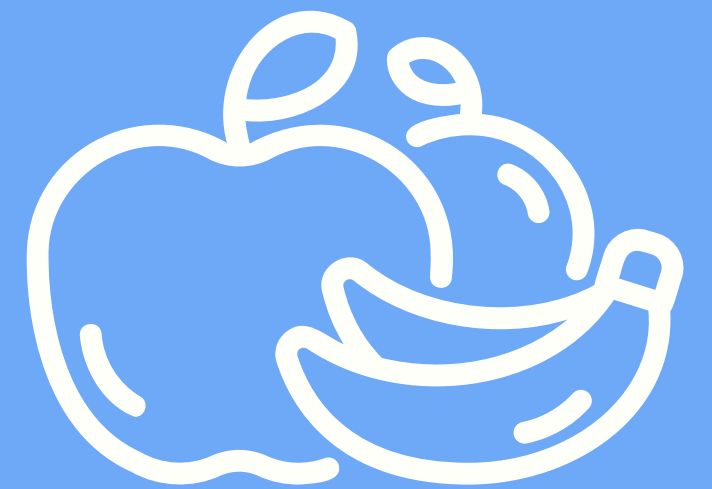
Buses are located on the side of the school (yellow hall).

Walker Pick-Up is located in the front of the school, outside the purple hall doors. Parents cannot wait for their child or walk under the breezeway.

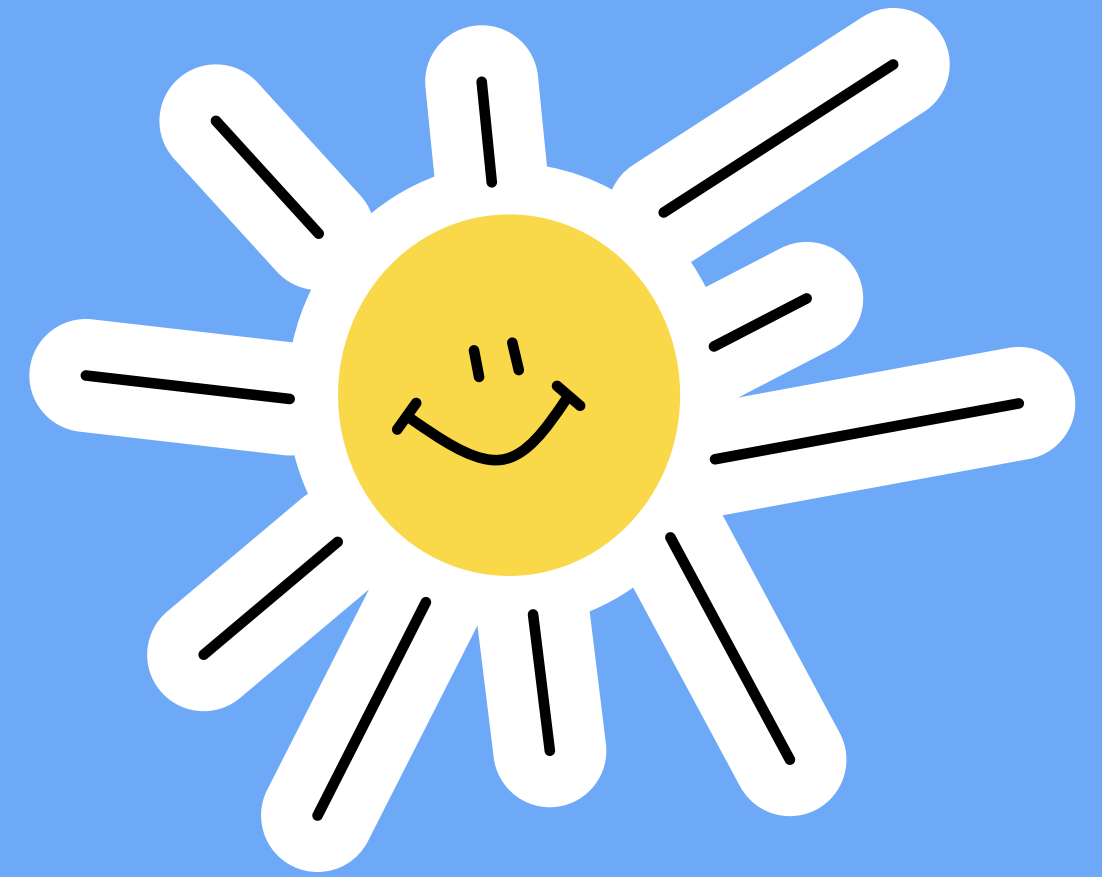
No parking in the front parking lot in the afternoons to pick up children listed as walkers, you can park on Tara Drive instead.
