

NORTH DAKOTA TITH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Scholarship Overview & Application Instructions

The Trade, Industry, and Health (TITH) Scholarship Program is designed to recognize and support students pursuing career and technical education pathways in Trade, Industry, and Health fields.

For the current application cycle, a total of four (4) scholarships of \$250 each will be awarded as follows:

- **Two (2) \$250 scholarships awarded to Trade and Industry or Health Science students**
 - A State SkillsUSA winner is defined as any student who wins a state-level SkillsUSA event, either as an individual or as part of a team.
 - State winners are still required to complete and submit a scholarship application to be considered for this award.
- **One (1) \$250 scholarship awarded to a State SkillsUSA winner**
 - A State SkillsUSA winner is defined as any student who wins a state-level SkillsUSA event, either as an individual or as part of a team.
 - State winners are still required to complete and submit a scholarship application to be considered for this award.
- **One (1) \$250 scholarship awarded to a State HOSA Winner**
 - A State HOSA winner is defined as any student who wins a state-level HOSA event, either as an individual or as part of a team.
 - State winners are still required to complete and submit a scholarship application to be considered for this award.

Application Deadline

All completed applications must be received **no later than May 1**.
