During her high school career, her participation in a variety of extracurricular activities also included Anchor Club, Varsity Softball, Science Club, Class Council, Yearbook Staff, Drama Club, Basketball Manager, and Student Athlete Trainer. Melissa's commitment to her school and service to her classmates was strategic to the very solid foundation upon which Houston County High School began its never-ending quest for Excellence.
