ENROLLMENT, ACADEMIC SERVICES, AND SUPPORTS

- Due to enrollment limitations, students must commit to Online Campus for at least one semester.
- Homeschooled students are welcome to apply (students must be enrolled in CCS first)
- Students who qualify may enroll in Honors and/or Advanced Placement Courses
- Students who receive SST, ELL, 504, or IEP accommodations are asked to consult with their case manager prior to enrollment.



CORE CONTENT AND ELECTIVE COURSES


- Courses will be facilitated by Carroll County Schools, Online Campus certified teachers
- Core Content and Elective courses will be facilitated using a blend of teacher facilitators and self directed programs (Edgenuity, Carroll County Digital Learning Platform, and Canvas.
- Students may also attend the College and Career Academy in-person to participate in elective courses. *You must provide your own transportation.

Sample Unit

•Subject material is embedded into the unit with added support from teachers

•Specific teacher feedback given on assignments to ensure understanding

•Collaboration with peers through discussion posts and live classes

Option 1: Attend a Live Session <u>and</u> Watch a pre-recorded interactive session <u>and</u> attend 1 help session

Option 2: Watch a pre-recorded interactive session <u>and</u> attend 2 help sessions



ONLINE CAMPUS LOTTERY AND SELECTION PROCESS


- We will use a rubric to determine student placement.
