# CTE Center & Ag Farm Update



# Startup

The SMJUHSD Board of Directors will officially accept substantial completion of "The Center" at our May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Board meeting. This gives us the green light to start working the land and officially occupying the rest of the buildings. We have some AG advisory meetings scheduled for May and I have offered the facility to other programs too, so we are hitting the ground running. #### **Getting Ready to Farm**

I have worked with our District Agriculture Department Chairs to solidify some earlier planning of how we will layout the land for production. The current iteration is above and may change over time based on our needs. Current plans are to have plots for Vineyard, Orchard, Row Crop and Pasture or Specialty Crops. Crop rotation and specialty assignments will be decided upon as a district each year during crop planning in October/November.
