Mardi Gras Parade Guidelines & Rules

(Please read, sign and return with your registration form)

We are excited about our 6th Annual Mardi Gras Parade! We have scheduled this year's Mardi Gras Parade for **Tuesday, February 10, 2026.**

Rules & Guidelines

1. Float designs must be based on Mardi Gras.
2. All parade participants must complete and return a parade entry form and a signed parade participation agreement to the Evergreen-Conecuh Chamber of Commerce.
***If you are not registered you cannot participate.**
3. **NO ENTRY FEE! Deadline for signing up is Monday, February 9th.**
4. All floats and cars and riders should be in place by **11:30am. and riders loaded on units by 11:45am.** The parade will start at **Noon (12pm).**
5. Parade Route starts at old City School parking lot.
6. There will be a designated **"Throwing Zone"** this year! It will start at the end of the bridge on Hwy 31 and end at Church's Chicken. This will be the only time you will be allowed to throw beads, moon pies, etc.!
7. All Alabama Highway Safety Rules apply. Age restrictions on drivers of motorized vehicles will be enforced, all motorcycle/ATV riders/drivers and lawnmower drivers/riders must wear helmets. **If you do not wear a helmet, you will be pulled from the parade.** All motorized vehicles must stay in formation. Motorcycles, ATV's, lawnmowers, etc. may not let space open up between them and the entry in front of them. There should not be revving of engines or "dragging" down the street. The same rule applies for hotrods and other cars.
8. **Absolutely no speeding or reckless motorized driving on the parade route.** Anyone who is reported will forfeit their opportunity to participate in next year's parade.
10. All participants riding on a float are asked to be at the designated areas and ready to start no later than 9:15am.
