I am so proud of the reading that I am seeing in class. AR has started and your student has been busy reading and taking AR quizzes. You can use the Parent Connect info sent home to check your child's progress. Don't forget that this is Bullying Prevention Month. Please keep me have those conversations with your student about why it's always best to be a buddy not a bully.



This week in **Reading** we will continue to identify and use text features to dive deeper into nonfiction text. Nonfiction means real. We are focusing on bold print words-big fat black words that show they are important, captions-explain the photograph, and subheadings-name the section or paragraph of information that is coming up. We will have a quiz after this lesson has been completed. We will review key details, main topic.

This week in **English** we will continue to identify and use collective nouns correctly. Nouns can be people, places, things, or animals. Collective nouns name the group of nouns. For example: choir of singers, pile of sticks, herd of elephants. We will have quiz on Friday.

We will continue Unit four in Fundations. Our phonics skill is suffixes: e. es. Ing, ed, er, est.

In **Writing** we will continue to discuss and produce narrative writings. Narrative writings focus on one small moment, has a beginning/middle/end, includes details, can use transitional word like first/next/then/last, and explains how you feel.
