Notes:

- -Brooks reminded team that we are continuing to lead the way to excellence
- -Brooks reviewed our CCRPI data from 2023 and 2024, noting many areas of academic growth
 - Students can be counted in more than one subgroup, data is up from last year
- Brooks reviewed behavior data with team, listed below:

(2024)

- 93.4% of students earned 0-1 referrals
- 4.67% or 29 students earned between 2-4 referrals
- 1.93% or 12 students earned 5 or more referrals

(2025)

- 98% of students earned 0-1 referrals
- 1.5% or 9 students earned 2-4 referrals
- .5% or 3 students earned 5 or more referrals
- -Current referral data for this school year: August(20)/September(21)/October(18)/November(17 at this time)
- -There is an overall decrease in behavior referrals, we can compare data from years back
- -Mrs. Brooks stated we are hosting behavior celebrations mid-way through the term to help motivate students and encourage good behavior, especially beneficial for younger students
 - Requirement is no referrals, dojo points are not counted towards entry into mid-term behavior celebrations
 - Mid-term behavior celebrations have been successful this school year; Grade-level bingo and Spooky Specials
- Team reviewed upcoming school events:
 - Picture with Santa event will be held on Dec. 3rd
 - Parents will be sent their child's photo on dojo and printed out only pay if eating/taking photo
 - Christmas lunch on Dec. 12
