Kindergarteners continue learning the silent tricky e that makes the other vowel say its name, like in the words make and cute. Kindergarteners are also working on answering questions in a story with a complete sentence. TK is learning about Farm habitats. They are learning the sound pictures for the letters Q and W.

Kindergarten is done with the math curriculum for the year. We are reviewing adding, subtracting, measuring, and teen numbers. TK is solving simple story problems with numbers up to 8.

We are also working on the end-of-the-year testing this week and next week.

They made observations and took measurements of the motion of that model and used that data to predict the motion of a real trapeze.
