Uniform Policy 2022-2023

**Girls Uniform**

Tops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Red polos with collars</li> <li>• School t-shirts (school logo only)</li> <li>• When layering, all undershirts must be solid navy blue, red, or white.</li> </ul>
Bottoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Skorts, skirts, capris and jumpers (navy or plaid #49 (Zoghby's) **Jumpers must be worn over a red polo with a collar</li> <li>• Uniform style pants or walking shorts (navy or plaid)</li> </ul>
Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid-Color socks (black, grey, white, red or navy are preferred)</li> <li>• Tights or leggings (black, grey, white, red or navy are preferred) worn under skirts, shorts or dresses - never alone.</li> </ul>
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Low-cut athletic shoes with laces only (Sneakers/tennis shoes)</b></li> <li>• Athletic shoes with Velcro are preferred for younger students</li> </ul>
Belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Navy, brown, or black belts</li> </ul>
Outerwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outerwear must be appropriate for school (face masks cannot be attached to garment or worn to school). Garments cannot have characters or other inappropriate graphics printed on the front or back. Administrators will contact parents if the graphics are not acceptable to be worn at school.</li> </ul>
<p>Pre-K and Kindergarten students will follow the Uniform Policy. However, Velcro shoes and pants with elastic waistbands are recommended.</p>	
Other Items of Concern	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jewelry worn to school must not cause a distraction to the learning environment or be a safety hazard to children. Due to safety concerns during PE, earrings must be post style (no hoops, loops, dangles, or oversized studs.)</li> <li>• Tongue rings, nose rings, or other facial jewelry will NOT be permitted.</li> <li>• No distracting haircuts, hair dye, hair accessories (including headbands with unicorn horns, cat ears, and other adornments), nail art (fake nails) or body art.</li> <li>• <b>No leggings worn ALONE</b>, cargo pants, sweat pants, stretch/spandex, or blue jean type material pants.</li> <li>• Shorts, skirts and jumpers must be no more than 3 inches above the knee (shorts must be worn under shirts and jumpers).</li> <li>• Make-up cannot be worn to school.</li> <li>• Hair must be a natural hair color.</li> <li>• Hoods will only be worn outdoors.</li> <li>• <b>No characters, lights, boots, ballerina, baby-doll slippers, Croc's, Mary Janes, Toms, Bobs, Sperry's or high top tennis shoes (please).</b></li> <li>• Clothing cannot be cut or torn.</li> </ul>
