Here is what is happening this week:

World History

We will start the week looking at ancient religions and trade. There will be a small project on the religions. Then we will start to look at Ancient Greece and Rome.

Government

We will start the week looking at and analyzing the Articles of Confederation, the first government of the United States. After that we will start looking at how the Constitution was written.

United States History

This class is moving towards the Revolutionary War. We will finish off the events that led to the conflict, then a timeline of the events in the war before we declared Independence, finishing off the week looking at Common Sense by Thomas Paine which helped to inspire the revolutionary movement.

Economics

This week will be spent finishing off the project that we started last week: "The Choices of Farmers". Scholars are looking at crops grown in this area, determining the costs of growing them, and how much money can be made. They will then make Production Possibility Curves to determine what should be grown.
