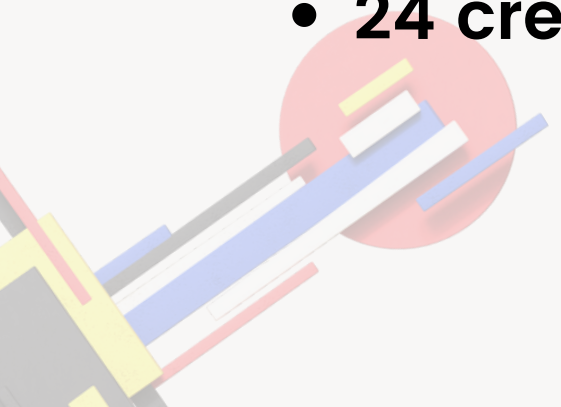

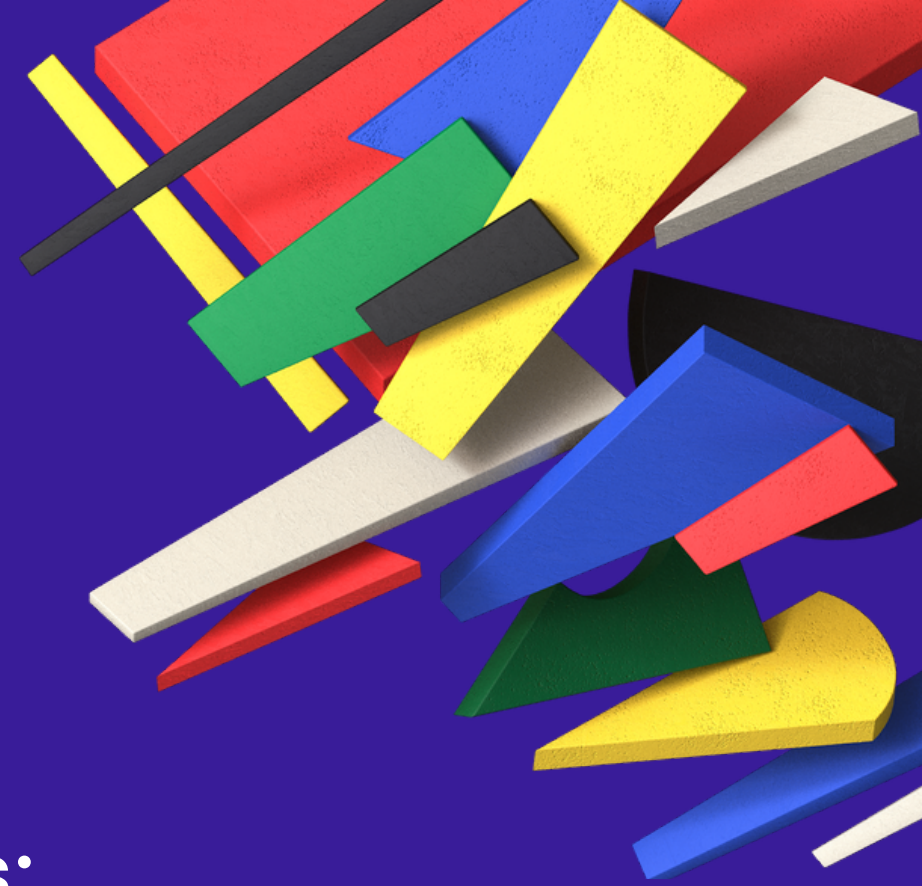

Looking Forward: Graduation Checklist – 2024

- Complete and submit FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) – OPEN ONLINE in December
- Create FSA ID – during OS – by Thanksgiving
- Apply to at least 1 college – FREE APP WEEK IS OCTOBER 16 – 20
- Have an ACT score on file
- Earn at least 1 CCRI
 - ACT Benchmark (18 – English, 22 – Math, 22 – Reading, 23 – Science)
 - AP Benchmark (3 or higher on any test)
 - WorkKeys Benchmark (4 or higher on ALL test)
 - Complete CTE Pathway (three course sequence with grades of C or higher)
 - CTE Credential
 - Dual Enrollment Credit
 - Military Enlistment
- Complete updated 4 Year Plan (www.al.kuder.com) – by Thanksgiving
- Complete and pass Civics Test
- 24 credits – regular diploma / 26 credits – honors diploma w/ 3.5 GPA (see handout)



Senior Ranking – Class of 2024



Schools will observe the following procedure for ranking students:

- Announcement of Top 10 will not be made until the end of the second semester of Senior Year.
- No member of the Top 10 shall be publicly or officially named until review and approval of hand-calculated GPAs by the Deputy Superintendent of Academic Affairs.
- Top 10 students will be comprised of those receiving the Diploma with Advanced Honors Endorsement.

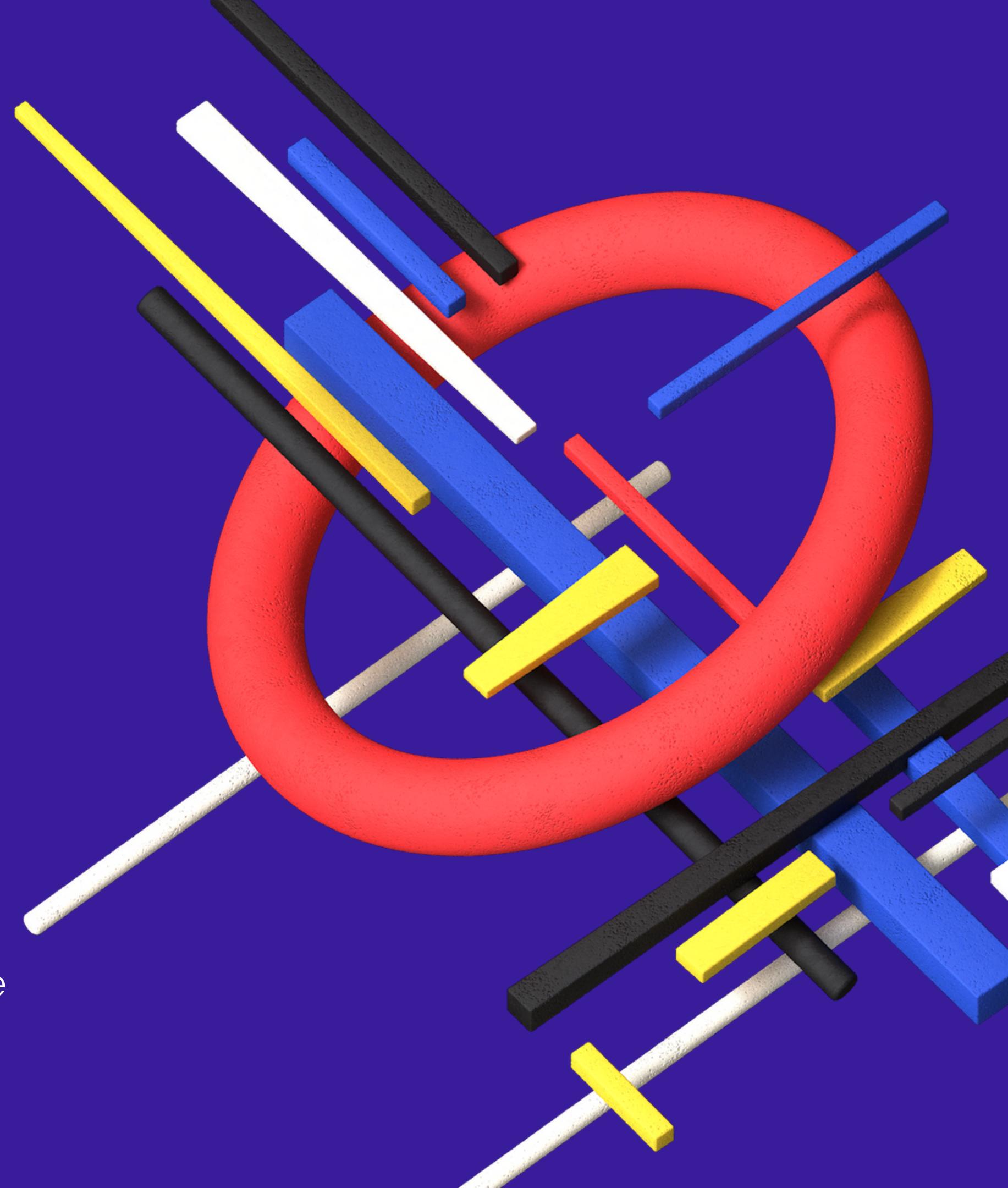

Generally due by December 1.

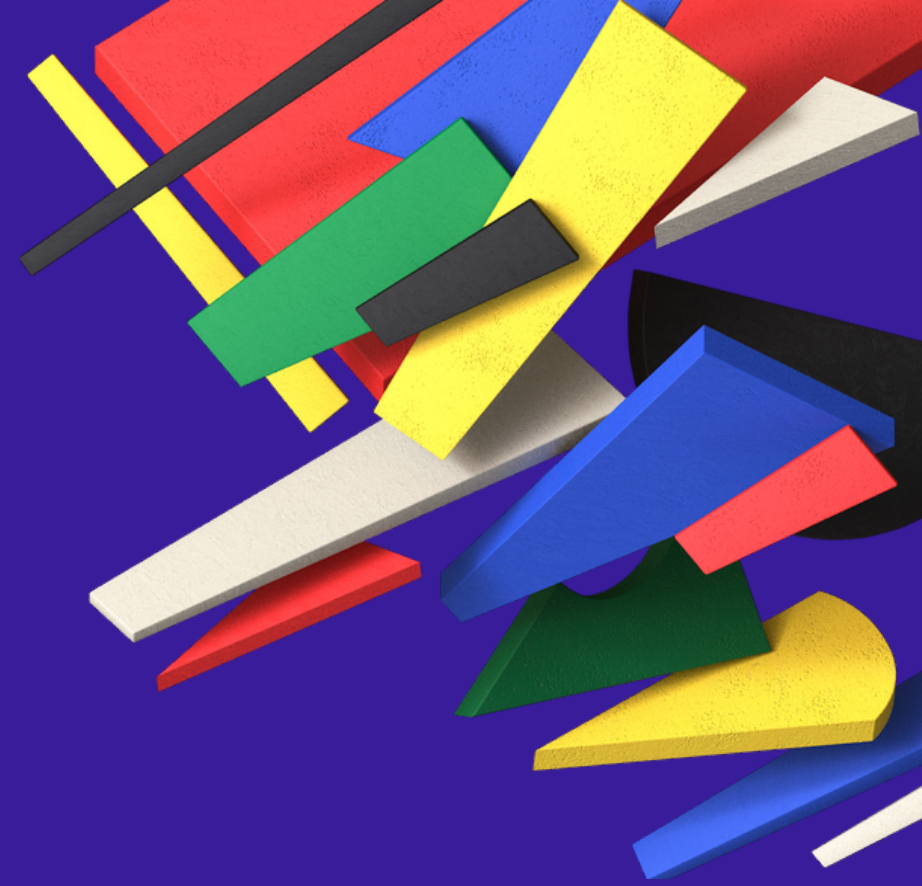
Completed online.

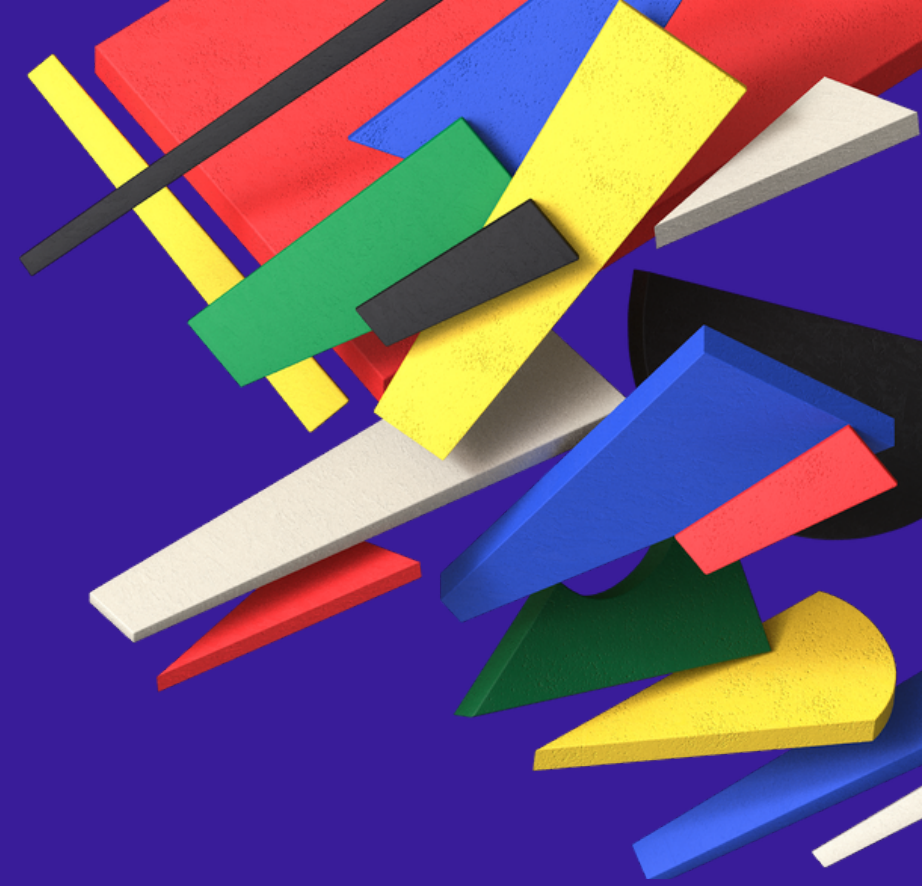

Final Steps

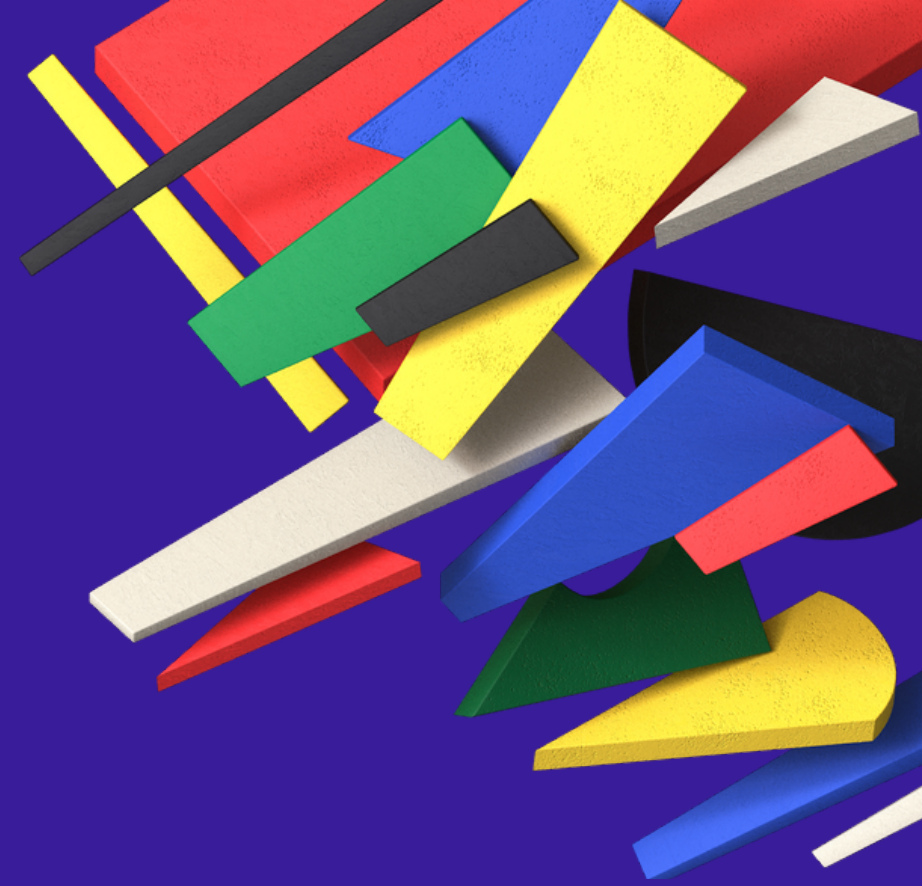
General deadlines are March – May.

Commit to attend college of choice.





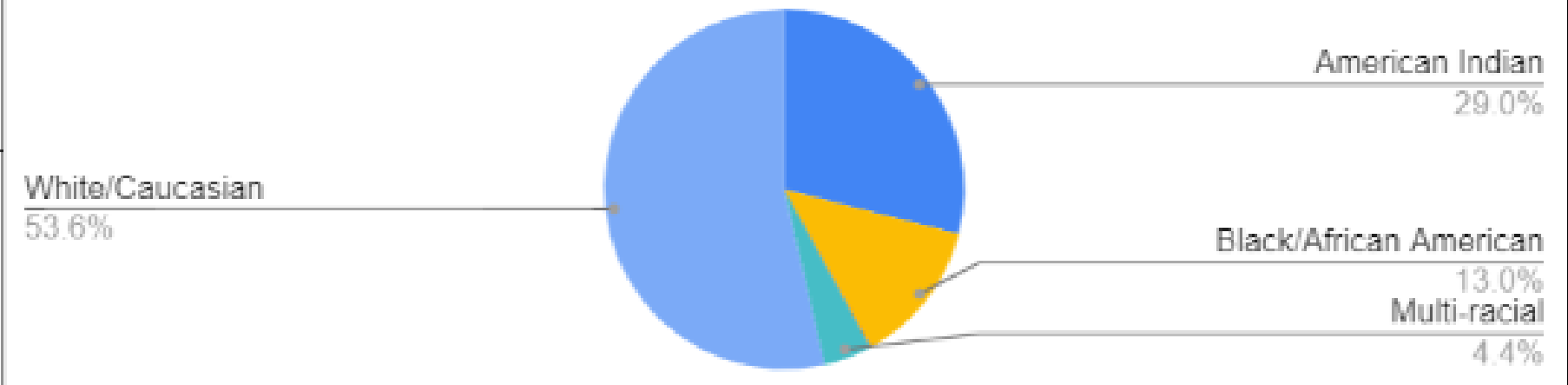
