
Agriculture moved into new facilities and built

We're on our way!






Freshmen Christened Baby Highlanders






JROTCInspection 'Well Done'

The club performed for Memorial and Veteran's Day services. Marching in the Homecoming parade was another function of the club.



King and Queen Crowned at Prom


