For the past 33 years I have served as a teacher in my hometown, Cincinnati Ohio. During that time, I have had the privilege of bringing high school and middle school students with me on service trips to Liberty, KY. Our four yearly visits (one each season) range from a few days to a week in length, and our group size ranges from as few as 20 people to nearly 100. For most of our trips, the Tuckers have welcomed us to stay at The Home. Once we arrive, the students say they immediately feel they are truly at their second home.

Spending time at the Galilean Home is truly a blessing for us "city folk", as Jerry likes to call us. Each visit we are warmly greeted by George, Rosie, Renee, Effie, Fredy, Jerry, Dawn, and many other friends. The good folks at the Galilean Christian Academy welcome us to stay in their gym for the weekend (or week). They tell us to make ourselves at home. The love we feel immediately fills our hearts.

Each visit we have a meal at the Bread of Life Café where we are always welcomed by Becky, Zach, Candy and many more familiar faces. Our large group of students snakes its way back to the banquet room where the excitement of the hot rolls, delicious buffet, and soft serve ice cream awaits. This meal is the most important, and most delicious meal of each visit. The comforting food fills our bodies.

While our primary activity during our visits is working at the farm of Jerome & Paula Lange, neighbors on South Fork Ridge, we spend time helping around The Home and visiting with the good people

that live there. The time we spend with our friends at the Galilean Home and time we spend working with our hands truly fills our souls.

The ministry that Jerry and Sandy Tucker started many years ago is deeply important work. Their legacy, inspired by their faith, extends beyond the countless young people from around the world they

have brought home for medical treatment or have been provided a long-term place to call home. Their legacy is deeply rooted in the hills of Kentucky, but more importantly, in the lives of their many children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, friends, volunteers, donors, visitors and guests who have spent a day, a year or perhaps most of their lives at The Home. Their lives belong here, and Casey County is being shaped by those connected to The Home.

For the past 15 years I have been working at Mount Notre Dame High School, an outstanding all-girl high school in Cincinnati. Year after year, the girls love their visits, many coming multiple times during their high school days. They come season after season, year after year. They crave fasting from technology, they hunger to become grounded through farming, and eagerly look forward to spending time with their friends at The Home. Some girls continue to return with me long after they've graduated, always looking to return Home.

I am blessed to count so many folks from The Home my good friends – Jean Beaudelaire, Abdul Samad, Fredy Caballero, Ebony Bright, and many others. These friends have shaped my life and my faith

and have touched the lives of the many hundreds of people, young and old, I have been fortunate enough to bring with me over the years.

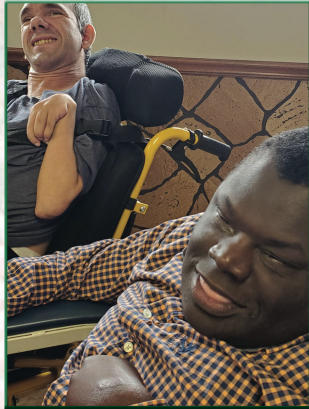
Thank you, Jerry and Sandy, Becky and Jessica, and the countless others that have been a part of this incredible ministry. Your hospitality, your love and
