REGULAR SESSION
OCTOBER 7, 2025 @ 6:00 P.M.

The Webster County Board of Education held its regular meeting on October 7, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. Linda Rogers, Donald Brown, Mary Hinman, Jimmie Johnson, Landon Matthews and James McCullough, Interim Superintendent was present.

Linda Rogers called the regular session to order at 6:00 P.M.

A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board approved the tentative agenda for October 7, 2025. A motion was made by Mary Hinman and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the August 2025 Financial Report. A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board reviewed the reconciliation report.

The Board approved the September 9, 2025 regular session minutes. A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Mary Hinman. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the September 22, special called meeting minutes. A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded by Landon Matthews. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the October 2, 2025 special called meeting minutes. A motion was made by Mary Hinman and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to pay Sheridan Construction in the amount of \$101,864.64 (pay app #10) for the renovations and modifications project. (Bond construction funds) A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the purchase of 10 computers and 10 monitors from Gov Connection in the amount of \$9,810.32. (SRA Grant FY26). A motion was made Mary Hinman and seconded by Landon Matthews. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to purchase 200 licenses to upgrade Microsoft office professional suite from Micro Technology Consultants, Inc in the amount of \$19,400. (Local Funds). A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Mary Hinman. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to pay Invision Technologies \$8,488.36 to upgrade the K-12 building security. (Local Funds). A motion was made by Landon Matthews and seconded by Jimmie Johnson.. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved the personnel agenda to pay Leslie Hill and Lou Ward the Cheerleading Coaching supplements FY26. A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board tabled item #23 on the agenda for the use of a school bus to transport runners for Tunnel to Towers Fundraising Race on November 15, 2025. (Pending insurance approval)

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:04 p.m. with a motion by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.
