

Dorchester School District Four Announces Annual Title I Meetings

The Title I schools of Dorchester School District Four will soon host their annual Title I meetings. Title I is one of the largest federal aid programs available to schools. Title I funds are used to supplement services already being provided to students by the local school district and the state, and the law mandates that each Title I school holds an annual meeting after the school year begins to review information with parents/guardians.

The more specific purpose of these meetings will be to share information about the district and schools' Title I programs, including plans for spending the 2022-2023 allocation. In addition, school administrators will share information pertaining to instruction, assessments, and parent/family engagement activities that will be implemented during the 2022-2023 school year.
