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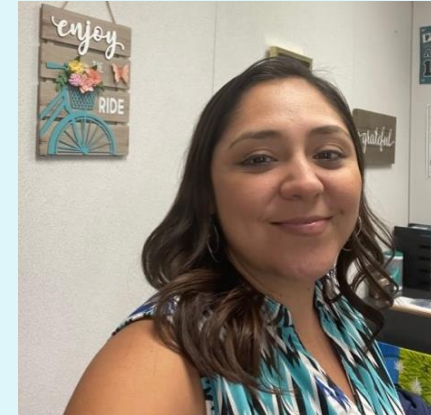

## PARENTS

If possible, provide student with a quiet place to complete homework.

Ensure the school has your correct contact numbers. Please set up voicemail and ensure it is cleared so that you can receive messages.

Sign up for Parent Square Notifications. Download the Parent Square App. Use your Aeries email and password.

Check your email DAILY (if we don't have an email on file, please provide one to the school when possible)

Sign up and check your AERIES PARENT PORTAL weekly to monitor your students' progress (attendance, missing assignments, grades, etc).

Check in with your student DAILY on work being done.

Talk to your kids on a regular basis about school, their goals, how they are doing emotionally and socially, etc...

Contact the school for help if you have concerns.

# Focus for the 2022-23 School Year

## 10th Grade Goal Setting Year

- Passing A-G/core classes with C's or higher
- Complete PE requirements
- Complete Algebra 2 requirement as a minimum if A-G
- Join a club or sport and start community service
- Complete any credit recovery needed
- Finish the year with 120 credits \*\*

## 11th Grade Planning for Life After High School

- Solidify A-G requirements
- Pass A-G/core classes with C's or higher
- Complete Geometry as a minimum
- Work on GPA if necessary
- Start/ complete foreign language requirement
- Start/complete pathway
- Complete any credit recovery necessary
- Post-Secondary Planning
- Financial Literacy/Financial Aid night (spring)
- Finish the year with 180 credits\*\*

\*\* Students who are 16 years of age or older and behind on credits may be referred to Delta to complete graduation requirements

# Requirements for University

A – History (P)	2 Yrs	
B – English (P)	4 Yrs	
C – Math (P) (Alg 1, Geom, Alg. II)	3 Yrs	4 Yrs
D – Lab Science (P) (Life & Physical)	2 Yrs	3 Yrs
E – Foreign Language (P)	2 Yrs <small>(same Lang)</small>	3 Yrs
F – Fine Arts (P)	1 Yr	
G – College Prep (P) Elective	1 Yr	

- **"C" grade or better in all the above**
- College Admissions Exams required for some private and out of state universities
- **Community Services:** University admissions and scholarship committees value service AND involvement in extracurricular activities.

# College & Career Readiness



## College and Career Preparedness Earns the PV Graduation Sash

### MEASURE A (CTE)

- 1) CTE Pathway & SBAC ELA 3+ score & SBAC Math 2+ score
- 2) CTE Pathway & SBAC Math 3+ score & SBAC ELA 2+ score
- 3) CTE Pathway + 1 semester college credit course

### MEASURE B (SBAC)

- 4) SBAC Level 3+ on both ELA and Math

### MEASURE C (College Credit)

- 5) 2 semesters college credit course

### MEASURE D (AP)

- 6) 3+ on (2) AP exams

### MEASURE E (A-G)

- 7) A-G + CTE Pathway
- 8) A-G + SBAC ELA 3+ score & SBAC Math 2+ score
- 9) A-G + SBAC Math 3+ score & SBAC ELA 2+ score
- 10) A-G + 1 semester college credit course
- 11) A-G + 1 AP exam score of 3+

### MEASURE F (Biliteracy Seal)

- 12) Biliteracy Seal & SBAC ELA 3+ score

\*Students must earn 1 of the 12 ways listed.

\*All courses in CTE, college credit and A-G measures require a grade of C- or better.

# COLLEGE NOW! / Concurrent

- **Allan Hancock College Now! Courses**

- Must be 16 years old
- Minimum of 2.0 GPA required
- Maximum of 6 units allowed
- TUITION FREE, but must pay for textbooks, materials, small health fee, and your own transportation



- **Concurrent Courses**

- Available to all grade levels.
- Classes are offered on campus
- NO FEES!

*Schedule a meeting with your school counselor to discuss eligibility, requirements, rigor of coursework, and petition for enrollment.*



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# Credit Recovery (D's and F's)

- Students will need to make up:
  - D grades in A-G courses in order to meet A-G requirements
  - F grades in any course required for graduation
- ITT/ ELO in place of elective (allows students to make up multiple courses through an online program)
- Possible Summer School
- Students not making progress in credit recovery may have restricted access to activities
- Students who are extremely credit deficient may be referred to Delta to complete high school requirements
