TREASURE ISLAND

Seaside High School drama is proud to present their fall play, Lux Radio Theater’s Treasure Island, based on the novel of the same name by Robert Louis Stevenson.

This family-friendly play takes place in England in the 1700s, when young Jim Hawkins, who usually spends his days helping his mother with their inn, ends up with a map to the nefarious pirate Captain Flint’s buried treasure. What follows is an eventful voyage to a “deserted” island, complete with a parrot and a mutinous group of sailors.

This play will feature an opening act by Seniors Riley Wunderlich and Skyler Archibald, who also serve as emcees throughout the evening. For the main production, seniors Kaiya Taylor and Ella Jesberger play younger and older Jim Hawkins; senior Sophia Reynolds portrays Long John Silver; senior Margaret Neuwirth is Dr. Livesay; and Junior Eva Bailey is Squire Trelawney. The full cast of eccentric characters and the crew includes fourteen senior students, along with a handful of underclassmen. The play is directed and produced by Susan Baertlein.

Performances of this tumultuous sea voyage continues tonight, November 18, at the new SMS/SHS cafeteria, and will continue tomorrow November 19 and Saturday, November 20 for senior night. Doors open at 6:30p and performances begin at 7p. Tickets are sold at the doors. Prices are \$5 for students and adults. Children ten and under may attend for free. Limited concessions will be available for purchase. Audience members will need to wear masks per Oregon Health Authority guidance.
