LUNCH CHARGE POLICY

It is the policy of the district to allow pupils in the Elementary and Middle Schools to charge a meal on the occasion when they may have lost or forgotten their lunch money.

The following procedures will be followed in the Elementary and Middle School Cafeterias for the 2022/23 school year:

- A. On the first occasion, the pupil will be served the meal of their choice.
- B. On the second and third occasions, the pupil may be served an alternate lunch; for example, a cheese sandwich, fruit, vegetable, and milk. The district will provide a lunch that includes the necessary components as required by the New Jersey Division of Child Nutrition.
- C. If the charges have not been paid after the third charge, a letter will be mailed to the pupil's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), followed by a phone call from the Principal.
- D. The school district will manage a student's breakfast or lunch bill that is in arrears in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:33-21 and this Policy.
- E. Any future charges will only be allowed on a case-by-case basis as determined by both the Food Service Director and Principal.
- F. The school district has a POS (Point of Sale) system that has been in effect since the 2010/11 school year. Deposits made into student accounts minimize the amount of cash handled by the pupils.
