Dear Parishioners, In a few short weeks, we will be celebrating the national holiday of Thanksgiving. This service will be at 6 pm

Wednesday evening, November 24, at St. Edward. I will be preaching. I think we have a wonderful service planned, and I hope that many will gather and give thanks to the Lord for all His has done for us.

Last week, I wrote a little about the good of the funeral Mass, and before that a little about offering Masses for the deceased. One thing that we often overlook until it is poorly done is the care of our cemeteries. Thank you to Martin & Laura Hennen family and Doug & Dan Maeyaert at St. Eloi, Dan Grengs at Ss. Cyril and Methodius, and Dan Sik at St. Edward for taking such good care of the cemetery lawns, and to Martin & Laura, Dan Grengs, Dan & Caren for their keeping of good records of purchases and burials and assisting with the marking for burials and markers. These are typically no easy tasks as there are so many expectations and the unusual growing seasons do not always allow for the lawns to look nice between mows or for certain holidays or important days for the deceased, but they do a great job. Thank you all for your work.

As Catholics, the respect we pay the dead is not ended at their last breath or even at the funeral Mass or even in their burial or inurnment in the case of cremations. We maintain a beautiful cemetery the same we should maintain our homes – with loving attention to the lawns, flowers, etc. that make it beautiful and prayerful. We believe that the cemetery is a place of rest for the body, and the deceased bodies lie there until the general resurrection when Christ will raise our mortal bodies, transform them into immortal bodies and reunite body and soul, where the faithful will live in eternal happiness and peace but the damned to pain and torture.

Care for the cemetery is a direct result from the belief in the Resurrection. Visiting the cemeteries is at times sad as we recall the grief of their departure, but also a moment of hope for them and a call to conversion for ourselves. During this month of November, Pope Francis has granted an indulgence for all who visit a cemetery to pray for the deceased. I encourage us to take advantage of this great gift.


