Sweaters: Council red sweater may be worn at any time


PE: red shorts (Council logo), white (Council logo) T-shirt, predominately white sneakers

GRADE REQUIREMENTS

Reading, Language Arts, and Math will have 3 Major Tests, 3 Minor Quizzes, and 2 additional quizzes per quarter. Major 60%, Minor 30%, and Additional 10%

Science and Social Studies will have 3 Major Tests and 3 Minor Quizzes per quarter. Major 60% and Minor 40%

RETESTS: Students are allowed one retest on one major test per subject per quarter. This is for the first test in which the student made a 59 or below. Writing is not retested.



• Students must achieve a minimum yearly average of 70% in each subject.

• If a student has a yearly average of 60-69%, students will need to attend their attendance zone school.

• A student who receives a yearly average of 59% or below in any subject will be required to return to the attendance zone school for another year of 3rd grade.

HONOR ROLL

- A HONOR ROLL
- 90-100% in each subject area including conduct and work study

- A/B HONOR ROLL
- 80-100% in each subject area including conduct and work study (all As and Bs, this does not include all Bs)



CARP

Third graders will check out two library books a week.

The books need to be read in class and at home. Picture books need to be read more than once. Students should take tests on both of their library books by the day they go to library. Students should earn one point per week. Work Study points will be deducted if students do not earn one point per week. Teacher discretion will be used for chapter books.

Students must maintain an 85% or above and make their personal goal to have their names called at the honor roll assembly and attend CARP celebrations.
