

Immunization Checklist

2022-2023

Changes to California school immunization requirement regulations will become effective beginning July 1st, 2022.

THESE ARE IN ADDITION TO CURRENT ENTRY REQUIREMENT'S.

- 2 Varicella (Chicken-Pox) vaccinations 1 month apart* required at:
 - K-12 admission or transfer
 - 7th grade advancement

- 2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, & Rubella) vaccinations 1 month apart* at:
 - K-12 admission or transfer
 - 7th grade advancement

- 3 Hepatitis B vaccinations at: initial, 1 month after initial, & 4 months after 2nd (3 doses within 6-month timespan*)
 - K-12 admission or transfer
 - 7th grade advancement

EXEMPTION(S)

- Medical exemptions for *new admissions* may be signed **ONLY** by a California-licensed MD/DO
- Each temporary medical exemption may be issued for no more than 12 months.

- ❖ The second dose of Varicella and MMR may be given combined.
