

MELISSA BROWN BROWNING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Melissa Brown Browning Memorial Scholarship was established at Houston County High School on July 21, 2021. It will be awarded annually to the Houston County High School senior whose high school career best exemplifies the spirit in which Melissa served others through participation in a variety of school activities. Melissa graduated from HCHS in 1995. She continued her education having earned her B.A. at Gardner Webb University in 1999, her Masters (Magna Cum Laude) from Baylor in 2002, and her Ph.D. from Loyola in 2011. Melissa left us way too early, having passed on April 8, 2021, at the very young age of 43.

As a member of the Class of 1995, Melissa was part of the first graduating class to have attended all four years at HCHS. From her freshman to her senior year, she was extremely active in her school, having served in key leadership positions in Partners Club, Prayer Club, Student Council, and FCA. During her high school career, her participation in a variety of extracurricular activities also included Anchor Club, Varsity Softball, Science Club, Class Council, Yearbook Staff, Drama Club, Basketball Manager, and Student Athlete Trainer. Melissa's commitment to her school and service to her classmates was strategic to the very solid foundation upon which Houston County High School began its never-ending quest for Excellence. She embodied *Beat Pride* at its best!
