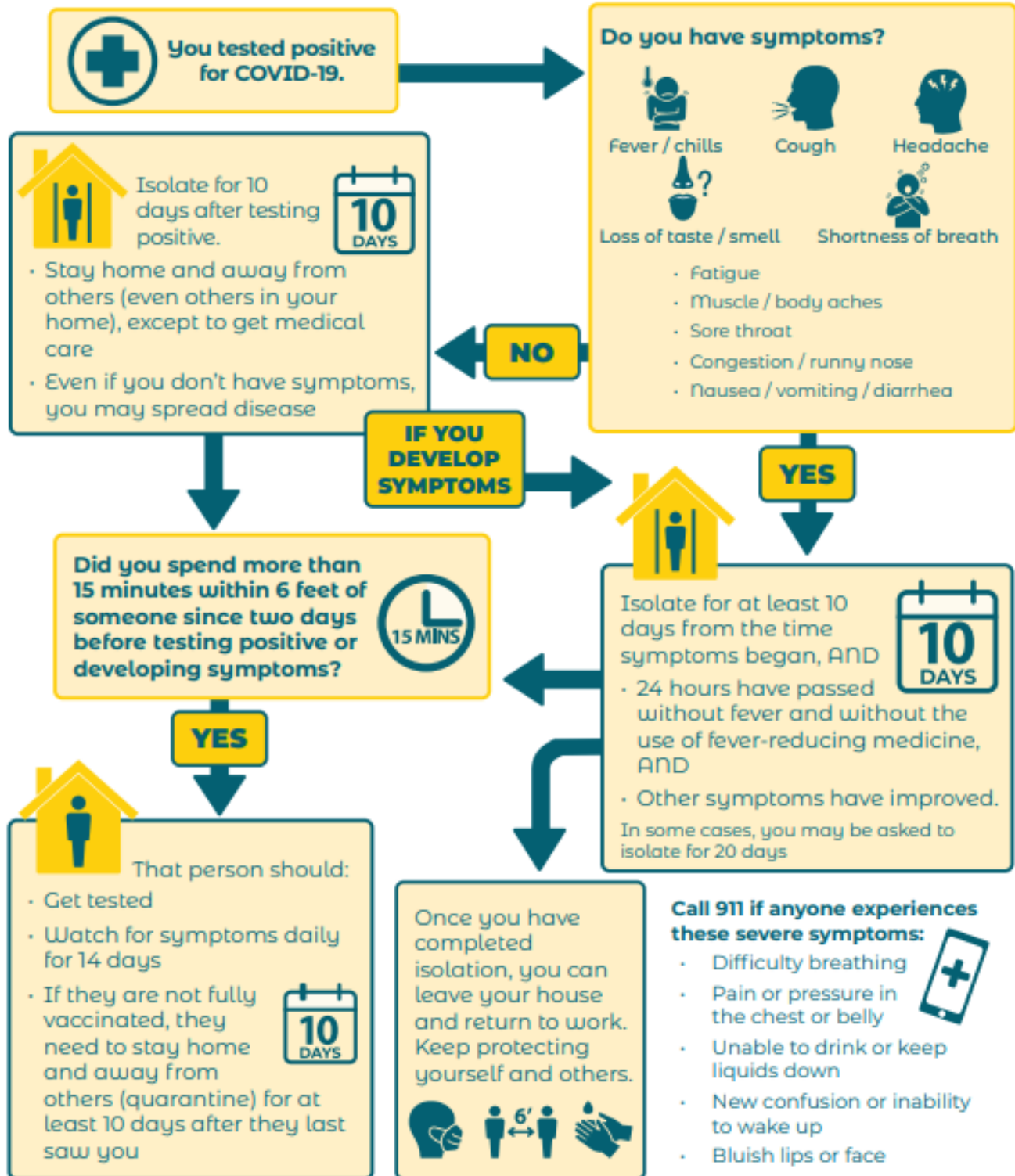

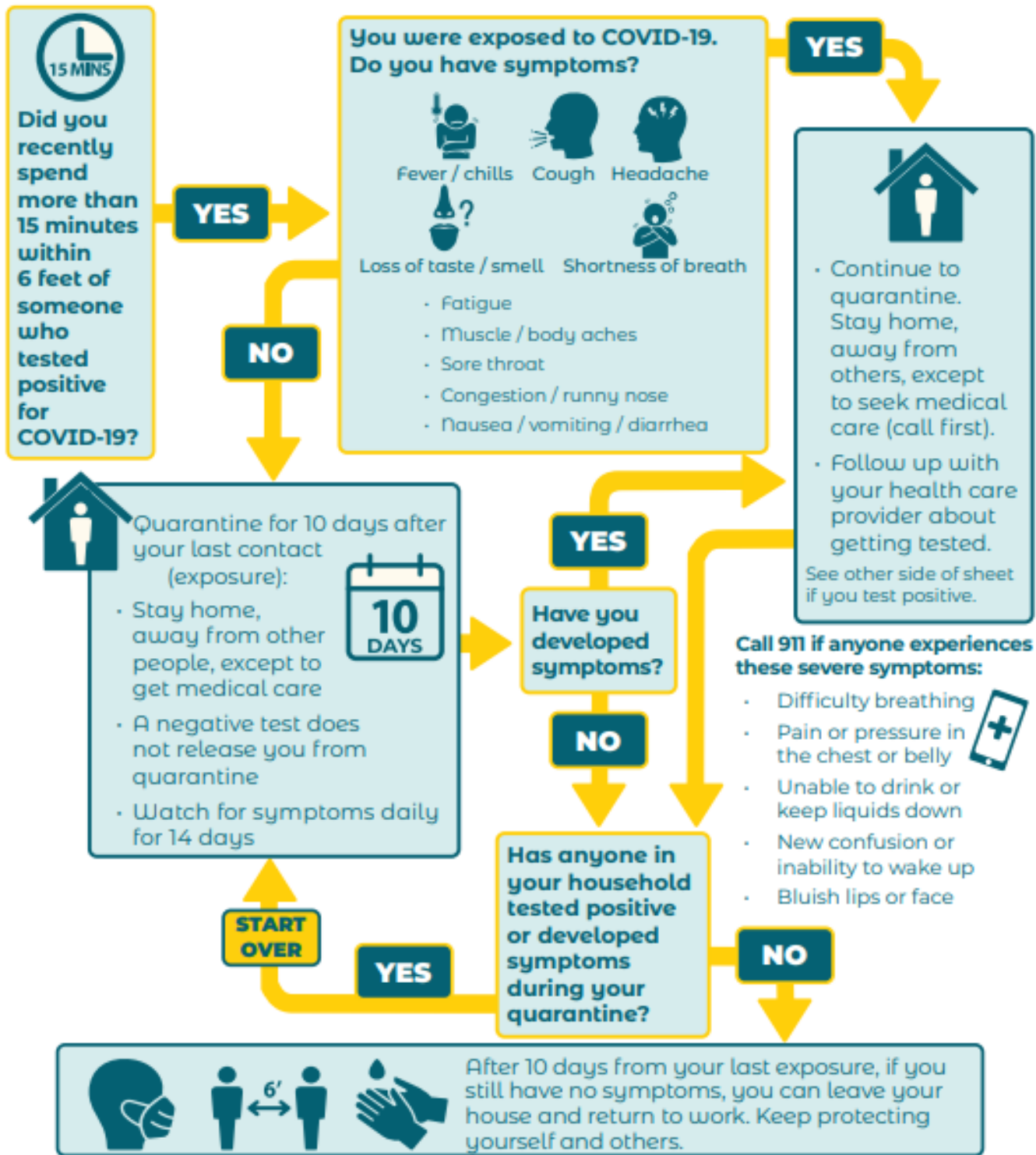

Fully vaccinated? You don't need to quarantine, but **DO** watch your symptoms for 14 days, wear a mask around others, isolate and get tested if you feel sick.



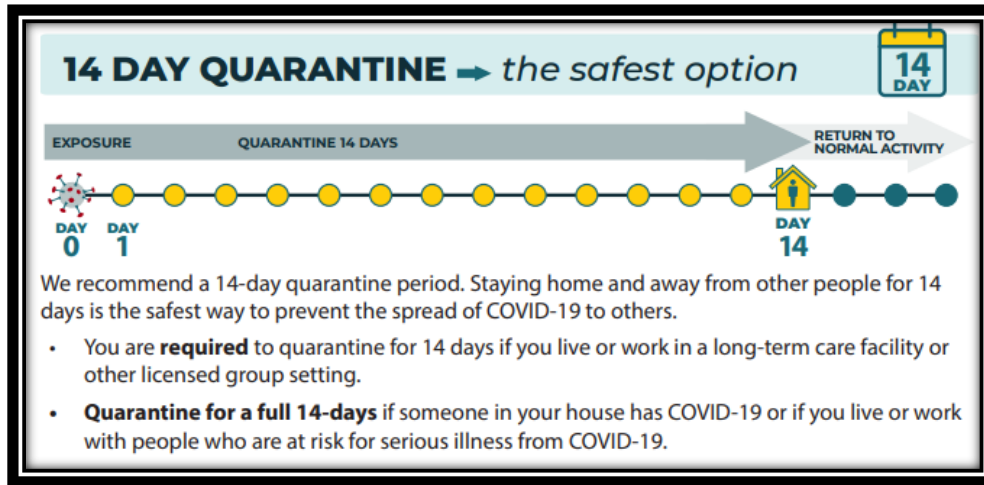

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Why does my child have to quarantine for 14 days?

Rainier School Districts works with Columbia County Public Health who recommends 14 days quarantine. This remains the safest option because even if your child feels well at day 10, they can still get sick on days 11-14.



### If I am required to quarantine, can I participate in outdoor after-school activities?

The quarantine is necessary to keep you and those around you safe. When in quarantine you may not experience any symptoms but you have been in close contact with someone who tested positive. The purpose of quarantine is to limit potential exposure to others, therefore should stay home and cannot participate in school events (indoor and outdoor).

### Where can I find more information about COVID, quarantines, and isolation?

### What does my child do about schoolwork when in quarantine?

Your child has options. If your child's teacher uses Google Classroom they can continue to use Google Classroom. We have Chromebooks that can be checked out in the event you don't have access to technology. Additionally, homework packets can be requested by contacting the school office or your child's teacher directly. Our teachers will get the homework packet assembled as soon as possible but at some times it may take up to two days.

If you are interested in signing up for Rainier Virtual Academy (RVA), you would be welcome to do so, however once a student enrolls, they would remain in RVA until the end of the term.
