- A. Approval of Personnel Action Report
- B. Approval to contract with Rasheedah Hameed for the 2024-2025 school year to provide homebound services to students who are served through an IEP or 504 Plan whose Least Restrictive Environment is homebound., Cost: \$25.00 per hour, not to exceed 7 hours per week per assigned student. Total Cost: Not to exceed \$5,000 per funding source. Source of Funds: Special Education VI-B Funds for students with IEPs and Local Funds for students served through a 504 Plan
- C. Approval to contract with Tamela Winston for the 2024-2025 school year to provide homebound services to students who are served through an IEP or 504 Plan whose Least Restrictive Environment is homebound., Cost: \$25.00 per hour, not to exceed 7 hours per week per assigned student. Total Cost: Not to exceed \$5,000 per funding source. Source of Funds: Special Education VI-B Funds for students with IEPs and Local Funds for students served through a 504 Plan

MCS is a program designed to prevent and manage aggressive behavior and to manage that behavior if necessary. The training includes de-escalation, protection, and restraint skills. Cost: Day rate of \$364.82 for 4 days. Total cost is \$1,459.28. Source of Funds: Special Education VI-B Funds.

Approval to contract with Soliant/Blazerworks for the 2024-2025 school year to provide related services such as physical therapy to students with disabilities who have such services in their Individualized Education Programs (IEPs).
