Sun Exposure

The highest levels of sun exposure occur between 10:00AM and 4:00PM. Overexposure can cause serious health problems including skin cancer. One way to protect your skin in the sun is with sunscreen. The CDC recommends:

- Using an SPF 15 or higher
- Using sunscreens with "blocks UVA and UVB" or "broad spectrum" on the label
- Applying at least 20 minutes before sun exposure
- Reapplying at least every 2 hours or each time you leave the water or sweat

Sun exposure can also increase your risk of a heat-related illness, including heat stroke, exhaustion, or cramps. Stay safe by:

- Staying hydrated with water
- Avoiding exposure to high temperatures
- Wearing loose fitting clothes
