Documents Required (Check ALL that apply)

RENTERS/NON-OWNER RESIDENTS

- Notarized [AFFIDAVIT OF RESIDENCY](#) dated within 30 days of registration

RETURNING STUDENTS

- Utility Bill dated within 30 days of registration, must include name and physical address (gas/propane, electric, water/sewer, telephone, cable, trash/disposal)

NEW STUDENTS

- Two** total of any of the following dated within 30 days of registration:
- Utility Bill dated within 30 days of registration, must include name and physical address (gas/propane, electric, water/sewer, telephone, cable, trash/disposal)
 - Renters Insurance (must include name and physical address)
 - Signed and dated lease and proof of last month's payment (canceled check/receipt) or notarized letter from property manager/landlord and proof of last month's payment (canceled check/receipt)
 - Housing letter (military personnel)
 - Notarized letter of residence to be used when the person seeking to enroll a student resides with a district resident
 - Department of Children and Family Services Voucher (must include name and physical address)
 - Social Security/Disability Voucher (must include name and physical address)

NOTICE

Only pupils who are eligible by statute may enroll tuition-free in the schools of the District. A person who knowingly or willfully presents to any representative of the District any false information regarding the residency of a pupil for the purpose of enabling that pupil to attend any school of the District without payment of a non-resident tuition charge shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor. 105 ILCS 5/10-20.12b.

A person found violating this statute will be liable for out-of-district tuition charges for each student whose residency was falsely misrepresented, currently \$10,000 per student, per year.
