Reasons updates are important are:

- Security Risks outdated OS's (Operating Systems) are more vulnerable to cyber threats and attacks, potentially exposing sensitive student data.
- Compatibility Issues Without updates the software may become incompatible with older OS's, leading to disruptions in learning or administrative tasks.
- Performance Issues Older systems might run slower and crash more often.
- Compliance Risks Schools handling sensitive student data must adhere to data protection regulations. Running unsupported systems could lead to non-compliance, resulting in penalties and legal repercussions.
