

# <u>Southern Local Schools</u> <u>Covid Protocols</u>



The Southern Local School District will implement the following prevention and mitigation strategies in response to COVID-19 virus.

## <u>Masks</u>

- Masks are highly recommended in the classroom, but are optional at this time.
- Masks are required for 10 days from the last date of exposure to a positive COVID case according to the Mask to Stay/Test to Play Guidelines. The student doesn't have to be excluded unless they develop symptoms of COVID. Refer to Mask to Stay/Test to Play Guidelines from ODH.
- Masks are required on school transportation per federal mandate.

## **Transportation**

- Students will have assigned seats on the bus.
- Students will be required to wear a mask to be transported on the bus.
- Buses will continue to be sanitized and cleaned daily.

## **Building/Facilities**

- Students will be 3-6 feet apart as space permits for social distancing.
- We will continue to keep our water fountains closed and use bottle filling stations. Please send a water bottle with your child to school.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for the classroom and high traffic areas.
- Plexiglass dividers will be available for classroom table seating.
- Cleaning and sanitizing will continue daily.
- HVAC settings will be maximized to increase ventilation and air filtration.

## Illness

- If your child is sick and having symptoms, please keep them home from school.
- Some common COVID symptoms are: no taste/smell, sore throat, headache, stuffy nose/ congestion, cough, fever, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.
- If the sickness continues, seek advice from your medical provider.
- If your child has a fever, they have to be fever free for 24 hours without using fever reducing medication to return to school.
- Sick students will be isolated if becoming ill at school while waiting to be picked up.
- COVID at-home tests will be available for staff and students as requested for symptoms.
- Ohio Department of Health Mask to Stay/Test to Play k-12 guidelines will be utilized for students to be in school.
