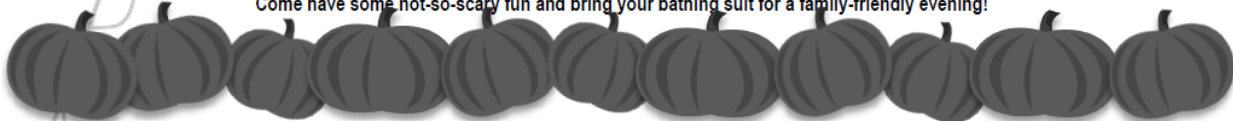
New! October 31st Trick-or-Treat Movie Night New!
