Just a few reminders:

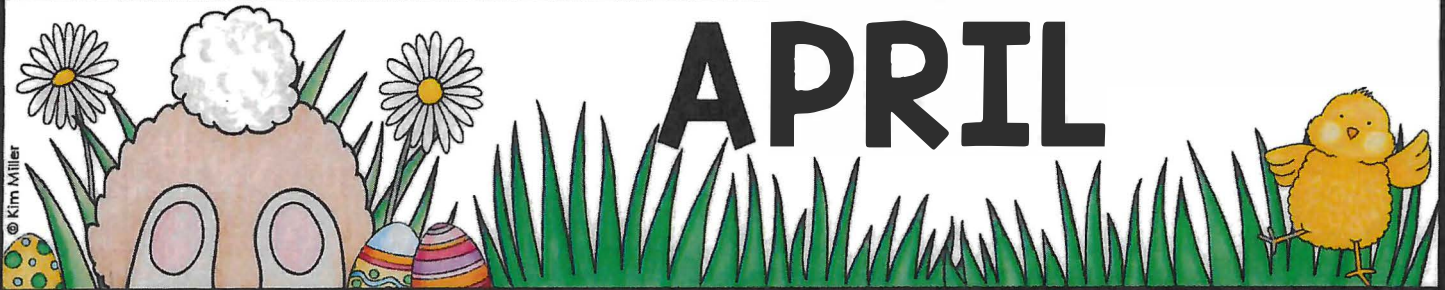
- The speed limit on Hickory St. is 15 MPH during school hours.

VOLUNTEER CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

MANY THANKS TO SO MANY VOLUNTEERS WHO HAVE RECENTLY OBTAINED OR UPDATED REQUIRED CLEARANCES!

All School/Parish/CYO Volunteers are required to obtain Child Protection Clearances:

- Clearances are required by PA State Law and the Diocese of Allentown.
- **There are no exceptions** for anyone under any circumstances. These are the rules and the law. Required clearances include:
 - **Any** Volunteer activity in the school or parish including classrooms, special events, CYO coaching or assisting, field trips, fundraising activities, etc.

IMPORTANT!!!

- If there is even a remote chance parents, grandparents, guardians believe they may participate in a volunteer school event, become a CYO coach, a CYO helper, etc. It ***is strongly recommended*** you obtain your clearances.
- If you wish an explanation of the requirements, I will be happy to clarify requirements or check the status of your current clearances.
- Anyone with current employment clearances who wishes to volunteer, must obtain volunteer versions of most State clearances – it is the law.
- **Please.....Do not wait until the last minute...**some clearances can take up to a few weeks to come through.
- End of year events will be here soon – work on clearances now if you wish to participate soon or in the 2025-2026 school year -don't be disappointed!
- **NSOR Clearance** – please obtain this clearance NOW if needed – it will soon be required. The application is attached. Check the volunteer box and send the completed form to the email address on the application. Send both the completed form and clearance, which will come via US mail, to my attention.

APPLICATION: National Sex Offender Registry Verification

The following individuals must complete the National Sex Offender Registry verification application:

- Any individual 18 years or older residing in the child care setting where child care is occurring.
- Any individual working for a Regulated Child Care Provider.
- Any individual with an ownership interest (corporate or non-corporate) in a Regulated Child Care Provider and who participates in the organization and management of the operation.
- Any volunteer of a child care provider, group day-care home or family child care home.

Type or print clearly in ink. Fill in all necessary fields on the application. Once completed, use one of the following three options to submit the application for processing:

1. Mail to the Clearance Verification Unit, ChildLine at the following address: Department of Human Services PO Box 8170 Harrisburg, PA 17105-8170; OR
2. Scan the completed application and email to: RA-PWNSOR@pa.gov in the subject line list 'NSOR Verification Applicant Last Name (i.e., Smith); OR
3. Hand deliver to the Clearance Verification Unit drop off box located at: 2525 North 7th Street, Harrisburg, PA 17110. Free parking is available in the visitor's lot at front of the building.

- Processing time is fourteen days from the date the application is received.
- Retain a copy of the completed application for your record. You may need a copy as proof of your submission for your employer.
- There is no fee for the National Sex Offender Registry verification letter.
- Refer all questions to the Clearance Verification Unit at 877-371-5422.

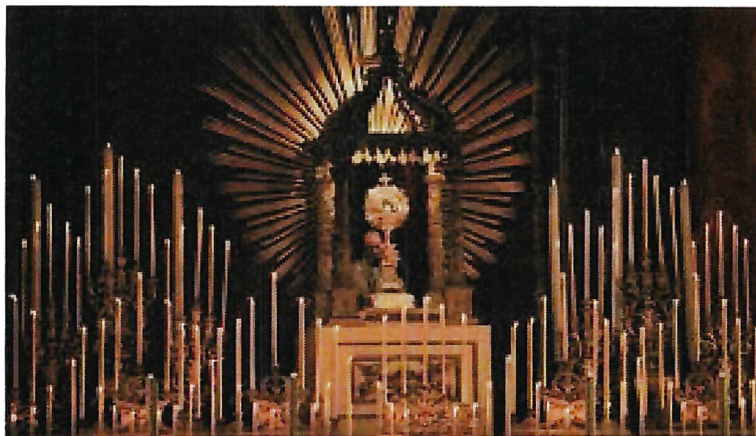
Father Mongiello and Staff encourage families to attend the 40 hours of devotion closing mass. It will take place on Tuesday, April 1st.

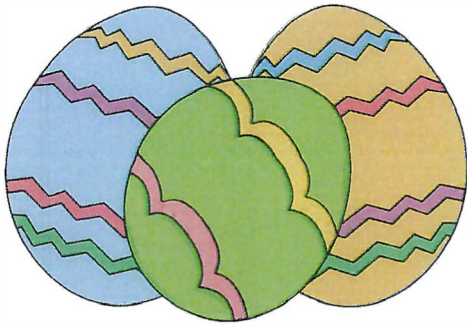
