SUPERINTENDENT REPORT!

One of my most favorite things to do as the Superintendent is to go spend time in the classrooms. I get to share with the teachers what they do well and some areas to help make them be an even better teacher. I have started my second round of Observations for each teacher. I am spending a lot of time in the classroom over the next month. I really enjoy seeing the students learn and having those lightbulb moments in the classroom. We have fabulous teachers and seeing them be excited about what they are teaching is a highlight of my day.

Brrr it is so cold out there. I am definitely thinking of warmer days ahead. I know it is a concern for parents when it is this cold for their children to go outside for recess. I just wanted to share with parents the protocol for determining whether we have inside recess or outside recess for our elementary students. Typically if the real feel is below 20 degrees I will keep the students in and do inside recess. If I have a question on the temperature outside I go outside before I make a final decision. We think it is important for the students to get some fresh air and be outside. However, with these cold temperatures I understand the importance of keeping them inside the building. Just a reminder that even if we are not sending your student out to recess it is really important to make sure they are coming to school with warm clothing. Even just a few minutes outside in these cold temperatures without the proper clothing can be harmful to the students.

The board of trustees is seeking input from patrons on whether to use district funds/ run a levy in regards to building additional employee housing. If you have not had an opportunity to fill out that survey one can be picked up in the main office at the school. If the Board of trustees decides to move forward with the project there will be additional inform tional meetings for the public.

There has been a few changes with the Dietrich School District Board of Trustees meetings and I want to make sure all patrons are aware of those changes. Our regular board meetings have been moved from the third Thursday at 7:30 pm to the 2nd Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. Rick Bingham was also voted in as the Board Chairman for the next year and Starr Olsen as the Vice Chairman. Patrons are always welcome and encouraged to attend the Board of Trustee meetings.



Dear Gabby,




