

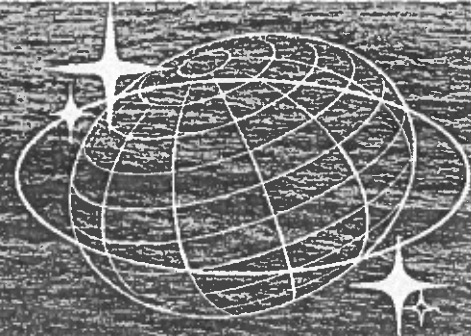

~Planning Checklist~

Fall Semester (August-December 2026)

- ❖ Work hard to make the best grades possible.
- ❖ Make sure you are on track for graduation –coursework requirements.
- ❖ Register to receive text alerts from Senior Counselor about important events
**** Text the message @tc2026atc to the number 81010 ****
- ❖ Use **YouScience** to explore career interests, and financial aid options.
- ❖ Use **YouScience** to research 3-5 colleges and save to your account.
- ❖ You get three excused days for the year to visit colleges. Please see Mrs. Rodriguez in the Guidance Office to receive permission forms.
- ❖ For college “early acceptance decisions”, be sure to submit all required college application documentation by the stated deadlines. Most early action applications are due between October 1 and November 1.
- ❖ Write essays for college and scholarship consideration – ask an English teacher to review.
- ❖ Have a resume ready to guide recommendation letters and scholarship applications. Use **YouScience** to write your resume.
- ❖ Request recommendation letters from teachers, counselors, or others – provide them an information sheet or resume along with the recommendation request.
- ❖ **Register for the SAT and/or ACT tests if you plan to take them for college admission.**
- ❖ Register for and take the **ASVAB** in November for entry into the U.S. military.
- ❖ Register to take the **ACCUPLACER** test for entry into the TCSG and/or 2-year colleges if required
- ❖ Check Class of 2027 Google Classroom frequently for scholarship postings.



Spring Semester (January – May 2027)

- ❖ Re-check you graduation status.
- ❖ Make sure you are on track for graduation (*appropriate courses/schedules, senior portfolio, etc.*).
- ❖ Register for ACT and/or SAT for college admission if needed.
- ❖ Complete your FAFSA at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>
- ❖ If you need a teacher or counselor recommendation, please request this at least 2 weeks prior to your deadline.
- ❖ Meet deadlines for college admission, financial aid, testing and housing deposits.
- ❖ Continue to apply for scholarships and submit them by the appropriate deadline.
- ❖ Notify the college of your choice of your final acceptance decision – May 1st is the final decision date for most.
- ❖ Notify the college you will not be attending to allow them to accept other students.
- ❖ Continue to maintain high academic achievement – colleges will be getting your FINAL TRANSCRIPT. Remember, your final acceptance is contingent upon your final semester achievement.

❖ **Transcript Request**

If you need your transcript to be sent to a college, follow the directions below.

- Log into gafutures.org (if you do not remember your password you can reset it from the homepage)
- Click on "My transcript" on the left side
- Follow the directions on the screen and click "send"

Proper Dress for Graduation:

• Young Men:

- Dark blue or black slacks
- White collared shirt
- Dark tie
- Dark (black, blue, or brown) dress shoes
- **NO tennis shoes, flip-flops, slides or crocs will be permitted!**

• Young Ladies:

- Dark color (black or navy blue) dress or skirt and blouse
- Solid black, dark brown, nude or navy dress shoes
- **NO tennis shoes, flip-flops, slides or crocs will be permitted!**

Please note that you will **NOT** be allowed on the field with anything written on or decorations on your graduation cap. **Adherence to the dress code is mandatory; failure to comply will result in not being allowed to participate in the Commencement Exercise.**

All students must check in with Mrs. Foreman, Mrs. McArthur, Mrs. Hill, or Mrs. Balkcom no later than February 26, 2027, to have their graduation attire approved. If assistance is needed with obtaining proper attire, please notify one of the individuals listed above as soon as possible.

We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring that the graduation ceremony is conducted with the utmost respect and formality.

Please sign to acknowledge your understanding and agreement to adhere to the proper graduation attire and return to the Guidance Office by August 18, 2026.
