DRIVER'S EDUCATION-SUMMER 2022 APPLICATION

Driver's Education at Custer High School will start on Thursday, June 2nd **with a parent meeting** and go until about July 22nd, or when all driving is completed. The classroom portion will start on Monday, June 6th. Class will be from 8:30am to 11:00am on Monday through Friday, for four weeks. Note: No group will drive on Monday, July 4th, in celebration of Independence Day. The last day of classroom time should be Friday, July 1st, and driving will continue for the next few weeks thereafter. The students will begin driving the first or second week of class, and will probably drive one to three times per week, depending on the number of students in the course.

NOTE: In order to be eligible for enrollment, the student must have been born on or before January 8th, 2008, no exceptions. By law, they must be 14 ½ to take the knowledge test. If not, please do not apply. Out-of-district students and ones that are 16 may be accepted if there is room after eligible Custer students are enrolled. The preference is for students that are 14½ or 15 years of age, and that reside in the District geographic area, including homeschool students.

---THE FEE FOR THE CLASS IS \$200 NON-REFUNDABLE for all students.

NO CLASS ABSENCES WILL BE ALLOWED FOR VACATIONS, CAMPS, OR OTHER EVENTS. Much information is covered during each class period, so attendance is critical. (In case of <u>emergency or illness only</u>, a student may miss one class, which will be made up. Any more than one absence, and the student may be dropped.)

A driving set schedule will be created shortly after the classroom session starts. Once students <u>have passed the written test</u>, which will be given on **Thursday**, **June 30th** for most students, they will get their **learner license**. They can then drive with their parents. If a student misses a scheduled group drive, they may be moved to the end of the driving schedule. If they miss 2 scheduled drives, there is a good chance they will be dropped from the program.

Make sure you put a <u>current</u> address and phone number on the application, so that you can get your acceptance letter.

There will be a <u>mandatory</u> parent meeting at 6:30pm, Thursday, June 2nd, in the new gym lobby for ALL parents/guardians and students who have been accepted. ***Students must attend this meeting with a parent/guardian, since it will be counted as classroom hours.
