## Learning about the Mass:

We will now concentrate on the Liturgy of the Eucharist part of the Mass.

After the gifts of Bread and Wine are brought forward and placed on the altar, watch as the wine minister and the servers or deacons prepare the altar. The wine minister pours the wine into the cups. The server brings the priest's book forward. The priest washes his hands. He prays over the bread and over the wine. We are singing during this time so we don't hear the priest's words.

Then we have a "discussion".

The priest says, "Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father."

We stand and say, "May the Lord accept this sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good, and the good of all his holy Church.

The priest says, "The Lord be with you." We say, "And with your spirit."

The priest says, "Lift up your hearts." We say, "We lift them up to the Lord."

The priest says, "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God." We say, "It is right to give him thanks and praise."



We then sing, "Holy, Holy"

Next we begin the **sacred** prayers. Watch carefully as the priest takes the bread, holds it up and asks God to bless it. Then he does the same with the cup of wine.
