The Rebel basketball teams had a successful weekend. They played in Custer against Forsyth on Friday where the JV girls won 19-3, the JV boys lost 18-26, the varsity girls won 48-40, and the varsity boys won 50-35. In Melstone on Saturday, the JV girls wons 21-8, and the other teams all fell short (BJV 11-43; GV 40-68; BV 42-51).




# Shakespear
