



## Creating a Strategic Plan for the North Wildwood School District

### **Mission Statement**

### Session 3

#### Developing Strategic Planning Goals for the North Wildwood School District

On March 6, 2024, North Wildwood School District administrators, Board of Education members, staff, parents, and community members, a total of sixteen (16), came together for the third and final strategic planning meeting. The topic for the third meeting focused on developing a broad goal statement and supporting objectives for each of the three goal areas identified at the second meeting.

Participants self-selected their small group goal area:

- Holistic Student Approach
- Community
- Mental Health and Wellness

The meeting began with welcoming remarks from Superintendent Mr. Philip Schaffer and an introduction of Facilitator Michelle Kennedy from the New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA), who provided an overview of the strategic planning process and the focus of the evening's activity.

The small groups reviewed the outcomes from meeting 1, strengths & challenges, and meeting 2, vision and initiatives. They began writing a broad goal statement and developing accompanying objectives that reflected their respective goal area's strengths, challenges, and visions.

**<u>Small Group Work</u>** - The information that follows is a summary of the work of the small groups.

Goal Statement	North Wildwood School District will develop and elaborate the student health and wellness while improving life skills for the student's holistic approach that promotes lifelong learning.
Objectives	<ol> <li>Provision of a wellness center to include nutrition, mental health, and medications.</li> <li>Improvement of after school clubs, enrichment programs, and expansion of extracurricular activities.</li> <li>Educational field trips to promote strong connections with natural local resources.</li> <li>Create life skill partnerships with the community for job placement and career experience choices.</li> </ol>

Goal Area	Community
Goal	To increase involvement with the community to inspire students
Statement	to become responsible citizens.
Objectives	<ol> <li>Create productive citizens through school-wide community service projects.</li> <li>Expanded interaction between the island schools.</li> <li>To support local businesses and community organizations.</li> <li>Inspire community outreach by connecting local businesses/jobs with job seekers.</li> </ol>

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#### Next Steps

The administration will create action plans that will identify the specific tasks needed to accomplish the goals/objectives, who is responsible, the resources required, the timeline over five years, and the indicators of success.

A final report summarizing the work and input from the three strategic planning meetings and the action plans will be generated by New Jersey School Boards and presented at an upcoming Board of Education meeting for consideration by the Board.
