This Week's Agenda

Spelling: CVCC patterns - olt, ost, old, ind, ild

These patterns are special because they all have a long vowel sound, but there is not any other vowel helping them make their long sound.

Examples include 'mild', 'hold', 'kind', 'host', and 'bolt'.

Reading: We will continue to read about fossils, this week focusing more on the job of a paleontologist, and the tools they use to do their job.

Math: We will continue to practice adding with different strategies.
