

Oxford Middle School Summer Math Assignment

Grades 6-8



The goal of the summer math assignment is to keep your skills from last year's class fresh so you are prepared to learn new math concepts and skills in the fall. It is suggested that learning sessions should be 15 - 25 minutes long, with no more than 30 minutes in a single day. Students should strive for one learning session per week. **Math teachers will check work for completion when students return to school in the fall. 1. Go to <https://www.khanacademy.org/> and sign up **using your Oxford Public Schools google account.**
2. Enter the access code for the grade/course you will be entering for the 2024/2025 school year and select continue.
3. *If you already have an Oxford Public Schools account in Khan Academy, log in and select "teachers" then select "enter a class code."
4. Once logged in, select "assignments" to view and solve the problems assigned.
