

## **Portrait of a Panther Defense of Learning Presentation Process**

### **Who is involved?**

- Senior presentations will occur in the winter.
- Select senior presentations may be recorded.
- A panel will include a combination of the following:
  - 1 Administrator
  - 1 Teacher
  - 1 Community Partner

- Students will be assessed using the Presentation Rubric.
- Students who do not meet expectations will be given feedback and allowed additional opportunities.
- Students who successfully complete a Defense of Learning and all of the Portrait of a Panther program requirements and have met all others requirements to participate in graduation ceremonies will receive a stole to wear during graduation ceremonies.
