

Mrs. Broadway's and Ms. Pasley's 3rd Grade Discipline Plan 2024-2025

In our classroom, we always work hard so that each child has an opportunity to learn in the best setting possible. This type of setting, in turn, enables every student to become the finest they can be! The students are learning how to be good team members in our classrooms, as well as in the entire school. To ensure each student is in the learning environment he or she deserves, we have developed the following criteria for maintaining a productive classroom climate.

School-Wide Behavioral Expectations:

DPES students will RISE!

Respect

Integrity

Self-Control

Effort

(Students will also adhere to the Autauga County Board of Education Code of Conduct Handbook.)

The following point system will be in effect for the 2024-2025 school year. We encourage you to sign up for Parent Square, and make sure you keep the app updated on a regular basis to ensure that you are receiving regular communication with your child's teacher.

Each class session, your child will begin with 4 points. If a student chooses to break a rule or exhibit a behavior issue, the following consequences will take place:

1st point lost from behavior issue - A verbal warning and the student will sign the behavior clipboard.

2nd point lost from behavior issue - Recess detention and the student will sign the behavior clipboard.

3rd point lost from behavior issue - Silent lunch and the student will sign the behavior clipboard. A student-teacher conference will also take place during this time.

4th point lost from behavior issue - A notification will be sent to parents via Parent Square and the parent will be notified by phone. The student will sign the behavior clipboard. Behavior issues that result in a Parent Square message/phone call will follow the consequences in the school's discipline plan. Please refer to the schoolwide behavior management plan to view consequences for issues that require Parent Square messages. This can be found at dpeseagless.com.

If a student loses all 4 points two times within a semester period, a parent-teacher-admin conference will take place. If a student loses all 4 points three times within a semester period, the student will be referred to admin for habitual class A behavior.

Students will participate in Fun Friday each week. If a student has lost 4 or less points throughout the week, then he/she will be able to participate in the entire Fun Friday. If a student has lost between 5-7 points throughout the week, a 10-minute timeout will be given. If a student has lost 8 or more points throughout the week, Fun Friday will not be rewarded and the student will serve detention during that time.

The purpose of this system is to create a positive classroom environment and to encourage your child to exhibit positive behavior throughout the day. Please understand that negative behaviors impede the learning of others, especially your child, and we want to make this system as fair as possible for everyone. This system has been agreed upon by the teachers and administration, and it will be fully enforced beginning August 7, 2024. It is vitally important that we work together in your child's education. A disruptive classroom is an unproductive one. This discipline plan has been very effective for students and results in positive behavior, better attention, responsibility, and more successful students. Thank you for your support!
