

Automated Traffic Law Enforcement System (ATLES)

Per Illinois Statute - (625 ILCS 5/11-208.9)

In Illinois, school buses can be equipped with automated traffic law enforcement systems (ATLES) to capture images of vehicles that fail to stop before meeting or overtaking a stopped school bus. These ATLES systems, in conjunction with participating municipalities or counties, allow for enforcing school bus stop-arm laws.

School districts must inform drivers about the use of ATLES by posting information on their websites and posting a sign on the bus itself.

Liberty CUSD2's standard school buses contain ATLES equipment that collects violation images for referral to the Adams County Sheriff's Department.
