Rocky Hill Public Schools ACETAMINOPHEN OR IBUPROFEN PERMISSION FORM

Per our Medical Advisor, Rocky Hill School Nurses are allowed to dispense Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen for ages 6 yrs and older under standing orders with written permission from parents/guardians under the following guidelines.

Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen may be administered in school for <u>menstrual</u> <u>cramps, headache without fever(temp >100) and dental or orthopedic pain</u> <u>under treatment</u> in dosages as listed below. If a student needs to exceed one (1) dose/day, two (2) doses/week or four (4) doses/month, their parents and/or primary physician should be notified.
