Dear St. Anne Families,

Catholic Schools Week is a special time each year when we pause to celebrate our faith, education, and school spirit, as well as the many blessings of our St. Anne community. We are excited to celebrate Catholic Schools Week together from Monday, January 26 through Sunday, February 1, and we look forward to sharing a week filled with meaningful experiences, joyful activities, and memorable moments for our students and families.

Because of the possibility of a snowstorm over the weekend we have moved our Open House to Sunday, February 1. I wanted to remind everyone that ***we have one remaining traditional snow day available. Any additional snow days beyond the third will be designated as Flexible Instruction Days. On those days, the announcement will read: "SCHOOL CLOSED – FLEXIBLE INSTRUCTIONAL DAY."*** We have many special events prepared for our students. In the event we have off we will do our best to reschedule these activities.

On Monday, January 26, students may bring a game from home to share and play with classmates during the school day. To add to the fun, students in grades K–8 may wear pajama bottoms with an appropriate school shirt or T-shirt. Students who choose not to wear pajamas should wear their gym uniform. A \$3 or \$5 donation for the week will allow students, faculty, and staff to participate in dress-down days, with all proceeds donated to Dream Come True.

The celebration continues on Tuesday, January 27, with a day filled with school spirit. Students may dress down in their Dance-a-Thon shirts or CYO spiritwear, paired with gym sweatpants, and are welcome to add green and gold accessories. In the afternoon, we will come together as a school community for our Catholic Schools Week Pep Rally. Students will participate in an energetic celebration featuring Olympic-style relay games and performances by our cheerleaders, including their dance routine. This will be another way to celebrate pride in our school.

On Wednesday, January 28, students will wear their school uniforms and may add removable red, white, and blue accessories in honor of a very special occasion. On this day, the Diocese of Allentown will celebrate the 65th Anniversary of its founding. We will gather as a school community for Mass at 8:45 a.m., and all families are warmly invited to join us. In the afternoon, students will participate in a Living Rosary in the Community Center as we pray together for existing and new vocations.

Friday, January 30, includes a Traditional Dress Down Day (following dress-down guidelines) and an **early dismissal at 11:45 a.m.** Students will enjoy a classroom movie selected by their teachers and appropriate for their grade level. Students will also take time to write personalized thank-you notes to Father Esposito and Father Tauber in gratitude for their guidance and support.

We will close our celebration on Sunday, February 1, by coming together as a school family at 10 a.m. Mass. We encourage St. Anne students and their families to attend Mass together. Following Mass, please join us for our St. Anne School Open House from 10:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. During the Open House, families are invited to stop by the Community Center for a special sneak peek of our upcoming Scholastic Book Fair, hosted by our PSA. Books will be available for purchase, and several school and community groups—including the Golf Tournament, Tricky Tray, Girl Scouts, PSA, Notre Dame, and BECA—will be on hand with information tables. It will be a wonderful opportunity to connect and celebrate all that makes St. Anne so special
